Senior Junk Haul - Again this year, 1-800-GOT-JUNK?, the world's largest junk removal service, is pleased to offer up to three bookings of junk removal per day, to elderly or disabled Carson City residents at no cost during Carson Pride Week!

The following restrictions apply: no hazardous materials; maximum of 1/4 truckload per household; no "bedloads" (this means no loads of dirt, sand, gravel, concrete, sheetrock roofing materials or other items of excessive weight); maximum of one half hour of service time per booking; limited to items that a friendly, uniformed two-person crew can lift/remove; service times are 9:00 a.m. - 4:00 p.m., Monday through Friday. Limited availability, by appointment only. Call 887-8898 and follow recorded instructions carefully to arrange for a pick-up time. Unfortunately, "no cost" appointments are limited, 1-800-GOT-JUNK? will not be able to schedule all callers. 1-800-GOT-JUNK? does offer senior discounts all year long for their regular junk & debris removal service to anyone not able to take advantage of this program.

Carson City Landfill - Open FREE to Carson City residents only on April 18, 19, 20, and 25, 26, 27. Stop putting it off! Pick it up, and haul it to the landfill while it's free! Please remember: No commercial loads. Also, the landfill accepts recycled items for drop off including car batteries, waste oil and antifreeze up to five gallons. Vehicle tires will be limited to four tires per vehicle during this free disposal period. For additional information, call 882-6066 or 887-2355.

Carson City Street Operations Pickup - Carson City Street Operations will pick up any bundled yard waste in the Carson City urban area put at curbside from Monday, April 21 through Thursday, April 25, FREE - 8 a.m. to 4 p.m. You must call 887-2355 for pick up. Please call during the week of April 14 - 18, 8 a.m. to 5 p.m., to be placed on the list of pickups. Please, garden debris only, no furniture, appliances or lumber. No ash or burned materials. Tree limbs must be in bundles and no longer than 6 feet and no larger than 4" in diameter. Bags & bundles cannot exceed 60 pounds each or they will not be picked up.

Wreck Riddance - Now's the time to get rid of that piece of junk sitting out in your yard or property! Now is the chance to have someone else do FOR YOU and AT NO CHARGE! Pick-N-Pull will tow away any old vehicles to the salvage yard for FREE as long as the VIN number is visible, and the property owner signs a release. Call them at 882-7772.

Adopt-A-Block - Schools, Garden Clubs, Service Clubs, Businesses, Churches, Scouts and Youth Groups - pick an area and clean it up. Heavy-duty garbage bags will be available at City Hall. Just fill them up, and the City Street Operations will haul them away. <u>Call 887-2355 to schedule a pick-up.</u>

Recycling - Support your planet-RECYCLE! Take your cans, glass, newspapers, cardboard and plastic for recycling to the Carson City Landfill Recycling Center. Take any reusable items to F.I.S.H., OARC, or the Salvation Army. Remember, Reuse - Recycle!

Household Hazardous Waste - If you have pesticides, herbicides, paints, old gasoline, etc., you need to dispose of - now is the time. <u>Disposal appointments are required and can be made by calling 887-2355</u>. This program is provided at no cost to Carson City residents.

Open Burn - The Carson City Fire Department will allow an open burning period from March 15 through April 20. Carson City residents wishing to burn must obtain a burn permit from one of the fire stations or online at http://www.carson-city.nv.us/Index.aspx?page=268. Permission to burn is revocable at any time due to weather conditions or fire restrictions. For more information, call 887-2220.
