16 _____ I understand that the State must prove the elements in the above paragraph beyond a reasonable doubt.
17 _____ I understand the following current possible punishments, and that they are subject to increased severity for
18 future offences:

19 1st OFFENSE: Misdemeanor: if convicted, the Defendant shall be punished by a fine of up to \$1,000.00 and may
20 further be punished by imprisonment for up to 6 months.

21 2nd OFFENSE: Gross Misdemeanor: if convicted, the Defendant shall be punished by a fine of at least \$2,000.00 but
22 not more than \$4,000.00 and may further be punished by imprisonment for up to 1 year.

23 3rd OFFENSE: Class E Felony: if convicted, the Defendant shall be fined at least \$5,000.00 but not more than
24 \$10,000.00 and may further be punished by imprisonment in the Nevada State Prison for not less than 1 and not
25 more than 4 years.

_____ I understand that, in addition to the penalties set forth above, the Court may require payment of (1) court
costs and costs of prosecution; (2) reasonable costs of the investigation of the violation; (3) damages caused
as a result of the violation up to the amount of pecuniary gain from the violation; or (4) any combination of
these costs.

_____ I understand that I have the right to have an attorney represent me, and if I cannot afford an attorney the
Court will appoint one, and I am represented as noted below, or, with knowledge of the dangers and
disadvantages of self representation, I elect to represent myself.

_____ I understand that I have the right to a speedy and public trial and I give up this right.

_____ I understand that I have the right to confront and question all witnesses against me and I give up this right.

_____ I understand that I have the right to subpoena witnesses on my behalf and compel their attendance and I
give up this right.

_____ I understand that I have the right to remain silent and not incriminate myself and I give up this right.

_____ I understand that the Judge is not bound by any agreement between the parties, and if I am not a U.S.
citizen, this conviction may jeopardize my right to become one or to stay in the U.S.

_____ I further acknowledge that I have been advised that if I am not a United States citizen, conviction of this
offense can result in deportation, revocation of resident alien status, visa or work permit, denial of re-
admission to the United States, and denial of naturalization should I apply.

1 _____ I am voluntarily pleading guilty/nolo contendere to the offense as stated in the first paragraph without any
2 promises of lenience or threats having been made because I am in fact guilty of this offense and/or because
3 I believe the State can provide the offense beyond a reasonable doubt. I understand that any state may use
4 this conviction to enhance the penalty for any future offenses.
