

RE: Utilization of City Funds for Adolescent Programming

This is an update for the City Supervisors on utilization of the \$27,500 grant from the City for Adolescent Programming at Carson Tahoe Regional Healthcare. Through September 30, 2006, \$19,240 of this amount has been spent on a variety of tasks associated with the adolescent treatment services. See below for specific amounts:

Based on this projection, the City subsidizes these Adolescent Services by approximately \$6,000 per month. This total does not include 26 hours pro bono to participate in the Carson City Adolescent Drug Court.
