RE: EMERGENCY RESPONSE EQUIPMENT AND OPERATORS

Carson City is soliciting your support in the event the City would receive a storm or emergency that is beyond our capabilities. We are securing a listing of equipment suppliers & private contractors having equipment and operators that could be hired at a pre-determined rate to work in conjunction with City staff and equipment.

If your firm is interested in providing such services, **please provide the information requested and return to this office as soon as possible.** A list of contractors, equipment and rates that will be kept on file and firms shall be called on an, "as needed basis". Rates provided will remain in effect **from receipt of your insurance and information to July 1, 2017.**

The City will require:

- (1) Motor graders - CAT 12G or equal minimum 12 foot moldboard, must have tire chains available.
- (2) Front-End Wheeled loaders with a minimum two-yard bucket capacity
- (3) Front end mounted plows, and truck mounted five (5) yard minimum sand spreader boxes.
- (4) Trucks suitable for snow and sand hauling to include end or side dump minimum five yard capacity.
- (5) Semi Truck and Trailers - 20 Foot Flat Bed trailer minimum with maximum 60 Foot Tractor/Trailer Combination
- (6) All Terrain Forklifts 4X4 6000-pound minimum.
- (7) Water Trucks - 2,500 Gallon Potable.
- (8) Backhoes – CAT 420, John Deere 410, Case 590 or Equal.
- (9) Dozer- Tracked D-6 minimum D-9 maximum.
- (10) Excavator 20 ton minimum with thumb tracked or wheeled.

All "Call Outs", instructions, supervision and payments shall be coordinated by Carson City Public Works Operations Division Manager or his Designee. The contractor must be able to respond within four (4) hours.
