Judge John Tatro receives Highest Honor in Judicial Education from the Nevada Supreme Court

The Nevada Judges Association consisting of over 80 Justices of the Peace and Municipal Court Judges from the Justice and Municipal Courts throughout the State of Nevada honored Carson City Justice of the Peace/Municipal Court Judge John Tatro for receiving the Outstanding Achievement in Judicial Education Award. This is the highest Nevada Supreme Court's award for judicial education and was presented by Supreme Court Justice Lidia Stiglich at the 2017 Winter Seminar.
