SPRING FLUSHING AND WELL START-UP 2017

Beginning April 3 and continuing through May 31, 2017, the Carson City Water Division will be starting up and testing wells in anticipation of increased water demand.

In a systematic approach to improve water quality, the Water Division may be flushing the water mains in the following areas: Riverview, Stanton Park, Woodside Terrace, River Knolls, Parc de Maison, Empire Ranch, Lewis Homes, and the Goni Canyon area.

PLEASE NOTE: Twenty-four (24) hours prior to flushing, the residences in the above-listed areas will be notified by phone via the CodeRED Emergency Notification System. You may sign up for CodeRED at www.carson.org/alerts.

During this process, sediment that has collected on the bottom of the water mains may be stirred up, causing discolored water. The sediment in the water is the result of the minerals that have settled to the bottom of the water mains during the year.

This discolored water may stain light-colored clothing; please check the water in your washing machine prior to doing laundry to be sure it is running clear.

Please allow 4-6 hours upon completion of flushing for the water to clear up. If after this time it has not cleared, please contact the Water Division at 887-2355.
