- 2. Mr. Kastens then presented the budget for the Parks and Recreation Department which included Parks & Recreation Administration, Parks & Cemetery, Community Center, recreation, Swimming Pool, and reviewed the corresponding supplemental requests for each. Due to the fact that a Regional Planning Commission meeting was scheduled for 7:30 p.m., the Building Maintenance portion of the Parks and Recreation Department Budget was postponed until the May 14, 1990, meeting.

The meeting recessed at 6:23 p.m. and reconvened at 6:30 p.m.

Mr. Kastens continued with the presentation of the Parks Budget.

Supervisor Fettic moved to adjourn the meeting at 7:05 p.m. Supervisor Swirczek seconded the motion. A vote was taken and the motion carried 4-0.
