A Liquor Hearing Officer meeting was scheduled for 1:30 p.m. on Wednesday June 28, 2017, in the Carson City Community Development Conference Room A, 108 East Proctor Street, Carson City, Nevada.

A. CALL TO ORDER

(1:30:35) – Mr. Plemel called the meeting to order and explained the hearing process noting that “this was an administrative hearing”; however, it provided the public an opportunity to voice their comments.

C. PUBLIC COMMENT – None

D. PUBLIC HEARING: ACTION ITEM

(1:31:27) – Mr. Plemel offered general comments to all the applicants, noting that he was the appointed officer by the City's Liquor Board. He emphasized the importance of the conditions of the license, especially that which prohibits serving alcohol to minors and server training. He also outlined the penalties associated with the violations.

D-1 FOR POSSIBLE ACTION: TO ISSUE A LIQUOR LICENSE TO REP ENTERPRISES LLC, DBA WHISKEY TAVERN, AND TO APPROVE RENE RICHARDSON AS THE LIQUOR MANAGER FOR WHISKEY TAVERN (LIQUOR LICENSE #17-32070) LOCATED AT 3481 HWY 50 EAST.

(1:32:33) – Mr. Plemel introduced the item. Ms. Sullivan presented the agenda materials which are incorporated into the record and noted that the minor items, to be remedied as recommended by the Health Department, were done. Applicant Rene Richardson stated that she and all her employees had already completed the required server training.

(1:34:14) – Mr. Plemel approved the liquor license for Whiskey Tavern, at 3481 Hwy 50 East, with Rene Richardson as the liquor manager subject to the conditions of approval in the Staff Report.

D-2 FOR POSSIBLE ACTION: TO APPROVE RANDELL JAY ROUSH AS THE LIQUOR MANAGER FOR MAVERIK, INC. #409 (LIQUOR LICENSE #17-26858) LOCATED AT 1451 COLLEGE PKWY.

(1:34:34) – Mr. Plemel introduced the item. Ms. Reseck presented the Staff Report, incorporated into the record, and stated that per the conditions of approval, Mr. Roush had already signed an affidavit of consent regarding server training, and that “he is attending the class tomorrow”. Mr. Roush added that his staff will also be attending the class with him.

(1:36:00) – Mr. Plemel approved Randell Jay Roush as the liquor manager for Maverik, Inc. #409, located at 1451 college Parkway, based on the Staff Report and subject to the conditions of approval.

D-3 FOR POSSIBLE ACTION: TO APPROVE MYUNGGUAN KANG AS THE LIQUOR MANAGER FOR TOMO SUSHI AND GRILL (LIQUOR LICENSE #17-29990) LOCATED AT 135 CLEARVIEW DRIVE, SUITE 124.

(1:36:24) – Mr. Plemel introduced the item. Ms. Reseck presented the Staff Report and recommended approval contingent upon a signed sworn affidavit by Mr. Kang regarding attending a server training course, which, she stated Mr. Kang had signed prior to this meeting.

(1:37:30) – Mr. Plemel approved Myungguan Kang as the liquor manager for Tomo Sushi and Grill, located at 135 Clearview Drive, Suite 124, based on the Staff Report and subject to the conditions of approval.
