CHRISTMAS TREE RECYCLING

Carson City is pleased to offer Christmas Tree Recycling in cooperation with Capital Sanitation/Waste Management, Inc. As in previous years, Christmas trees can be placed curbside on your regular trash collection day or taken to one of the drop-off locations. Trees will be chipped in the springtime and used as mulch. This program continues to be a huge success. Carson City would like to thank everyone for their participation. Last year, we were able to redirect 34 tons of wood waste from our landfill.

The dates for curbside tree collection are:

Monday, January 7, 2019 to Friday, January 13, 2019 on your regular trash day.

If trees are longer than six feet, please cut them up into sections no longer than six feet.

Christmas tree drop off bins will be at the following Carson City locations beginning Monday, Jan. 7, 2019:

Big Lots parking lot at Clearview and South Carson Street
Public Works Yard at Airport and East Fifth Street
Bully's parking lot, 3530 North Carson Street
Waste Management parking lot at 5560 Sheep Drive
Carson City Landfill (Green Waste Pile)

After January 13, 2019:

Please take your Christmas tree to the Carson City Landfill for recycling.

Trees left curbside after January 13 will be disposed of as garbage and will need to be cut into 3-foot sections so they will fit into the Waste Management trucks.

PLEASE NOTE:

Remove all decorations, lights, tinsel and bases from the trees before recycling. Call the Carson City Environmental Control Authority at 887-2355, ext. 7390, 7380 or 7376 for more information.
