Staff Summary: As a result of reports of errant bullets observed overhead and landing in the landfill, which is adjacent to the Carson Rifle and Pistol Range (the Range), staff engaged the services of third party technical experts to conduct safety assessments of the Range. Staff is requesting the Board create a task force to review the results of the assessments and make recommendations to the Board.

Background/Issues & Analysis

Errant bullets have been reported overhead and landing at the adjacent landfill, which is a significant concern. Since the landfill is adjacent to the Range, staff has taken measures to protect the safety of the public and employees by limiting the hours of operation at the range and ensuring that Range Safety Officers provided by the Carson Rifle and Pistol Club oversee the Range operations during those hours.

Additionally, staff engaged the services of third-party technical experts to assess the design, safety, and operation of the Range. Any recommendations made should be reviewed by a group of interested individuals with the focus on the interests and safety of the public at large.
