#### INSURANCE

#### **PAYMENT & CANCELLATION**

50% of the total rental charges must be received 20 working days prior to each event to hold the reservation. 100% of all fees and the required forms must be received 10 working days prior. Purchase orders will also be accepted from local government agencies. Cleaning deposits may be refunded and take approximately 2-3 weeks to process. FINAL CHARGES WILL BE DETERMINED AFTER THE EVENT. Any charges over the estimate shown on this contract will be deducted from any cleaning deposits. If the cleaning deposit is not enough to cover all of the charges, the additional amount will be billed to you and due within 30 days. If the estimate shown on this contract is lower than the actual charges, a refund will be issued. Refunds for cancellations can be processed as long as minimum prior notice of 20 working days is given. The refund will be subject to a 10% processing fee and takes approximately 2-3 weeks.

#### RENTER RESPONSIBILITIES

THE RENTER IS RESPONSIBLE FOR all set up of tables & chairs. The renter is responsible for clean up and removal of any decorations, etc. used.
