ACTION ON APPROVAL OF MINUTES - JUNE 21, 2007 (8:37:50) - Member Livermore moved for approval of the June 21, 2007, Liquor and Entertainment Board Meeting Minutes as presented. Member Aldean seconded the motion. Motion carried 5-0.

3. DEVELOPMENT SERVICES - PLANNING - Director Walter Sullivan - ACTION TO APPROVE A FULL (PACKAGED) LIQUOR LICENSE FOR NEVADA CVS PHARMACY, LLC, (LIQUOR MANAGER: JEFFERY G. DE LA PENA) FOR LONGS CVS/PHARMACY NO. 8779, LOCATED AT 220 FAIRVIEW DRIVE, CARSON CITY, NEVADA (8:38:13) - Jeffery De La Pena indicated that he knew the Board's concerns regarding the sale of liquor to minors. He described the company's policy regarding identification requirements for those under the age of 30. He had been with the firm for 17 years and purported that he had never been caught in a sting. Training for the employees is provided. Member Furlong indicated that the Sheriff's Office did not object to his licensing. Member Williamson moved to approve a full packaged liquor license for Nevada CVS Pharmacy, LLC, Liquor Manager Jeffery De La Pena, for Longs CVS Pharmacy No. 8779, located at 220 Fairview Drive, Carson City, Nevada and no fiscal impact. Member Livermore seconded the motion. Motion carried 5-0.
