AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CARSON CITY MUNICIPAL CODE TITLE 2, ADMINISTRATION AND PERSONNEL, CHAPTER 2.28, ELECTION BOARD OFFICERS, SECTION 2.28.010, COMPENSATION FOR ELECTION BOARD OFFICERS, BY PROVIDING THAT THE COMPENSATION AND CONDITIONS OF EMPLOYMENT FOR CERTAIN ELECTION BOARD OFFICERS IS TO BE FIXED BY A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS, AND OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO.

THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF CARSON CITY DO ORDAIN:

## Section I:

Section 2.28.010 of the Carson City Municipal Code is hereby amended as follows:

[Voting board officers, counting board officers, specially appointed deputy sheriffs and other election board officers shall be paid three dollars and thirty-five cents (\$3.35) for each hour's services that are actually performed during the day of every election conducted in Carson City.]

The compensation and conditions of employment for voting board officers, counting board officers, those employees for the purpose of conduction early voting, specially appointed deputy sheriffs and other election board officers shall be fixed by resolution of the Board of Supervisors.

## SECTION II:

That no other provisions of the Carson City Municipal Code are affected by this ordinance.
