Dear Andy:

On behalf of the Commission for the Reconstruction of the V&T Railway, I would like to take this opportunity to request that Carson City consider assisting the Railway Commission with the relocation of a segment of the City's water line in conjunction with the upcoming Phase 2C Railroad Construction.

In order to proceed with the construction of Phase 2C, we will need to construct an embankment, or fill section, over a short segment of Carson City's watermain serving the new tank east of Flint Drive. The proposed railroad crosses the watermain just as it turns 90-degrees "up" the hill east of Flint Drive. In order to protect the watermain and provide for future maintenance requirements, the watermain should be placed in a steel casing pipe. The Commission would like to request that the Carson City Public Works Department provide the necessary watermain design and relocation work and casing construction at this location in support of the railroad project.

For your information, the Railway Commission will be will be including the completion of the fill placement for the City's waterline access road near this location out to Flint Drive as a part of the Phase 2C project.
