




TOTAL POOL EXPERIENCE

The claims count for all members per year has averaged 452 per open year. Membership doubled since 1998, although claims activity appears to have stabilized over the open ten years. Open claims total 261 for the period or about 6% of all incidents and claims incurred.

POOL CLAIMS FREQUENCY



Severity, for the ten open years, based on total loss costs incurred without deduction for excess insurance or deductibles, has averaged \$3,597,343 with the worst year at \$9,227,838 comprising 26% of total costs for all ten years. Net of member deductibles and of excess insurance payments, the POOL's retained incurred claims for the open years averaged \$2,142,420. On a cost per claim basis the average net per claim cost is \$4,378.
