SUBJECT: Suspended and Vacant General Fund Positions

Attached is a list of the general fund positions that were suspended voluntarily by the General Fund departments or held vacant by the hiring freeze imposed last October.

As discussed during the meeting when the Board approved and adopted the final 2008/2009 Budget, I will be asking the department directors and elected officials to prioritize the list. The purpose is twofold; the first is to develop a ranking of the positions to restore should revenues start to increase and the second is to develop a process to weigh future vacancies against. For example, if a vacancy occurs in the future, that position will be judged against the prioritized list to determine which position should be filled.

Additionally, there may be situations where a vacant or suspended position needs to be filled based operation necessities and in that case, an equal reduction in expenses will be imposed.

At the second Board meeting of each month, I will provide you with a status report showing any changes to the list and the resultant change in funding.
