Subject Title: Action to accept Public Works recommendation on the "Carson City Freeway Phase 2 Utility Relocations Project", Contract No. 2002-002 Amendment No. #3 and authorize Public Works to issue additional payment to The Louis Berger Group in an amount not to exceed \$190,000.00 from the NDOT Utility By-Pass Funds as provided in FY 2008/2009.

Staff Summary: This amendment addressed additional elements of work required for the Phase 2 Utility Relocation Project for Phase 2 of the Carson City Freeway. This amendment includes additional design effort to accommodate utility clearance changes required by NDOT, additional coordination with other utilities, additional reviews by State NDEP Bureau of Safe Drinking Water, additional documentation as required by NDOT, additional design due to criteria and standards changed by NDOT, and additional Cultural Resources Investigations. NDOT will reimburse Carson City for the majority of the additional costs.

The original agreement was approved May 15, 2003 in the amount of \$291,730.16 and a contingency of \$30,000.00. Amendment No.1 was issued December 27, 2004, using the \$30,000.00 contingency. Amendment No. 2 was approved February 17, 2005 in the amount of \$572,270.00 and a contingency amount of \$50,000.00 however Louis Berger was not authorized by Public Works to spend the contingency. The attached proposal from The Louis Berger Group is a request for additional funding of \$240,000.00. With the authorization of Public Works for Louis Berger to spend the contingency and the inclusion of this Amendment No. 3 for \$190,000.00 the new contract sum is \$1,134,000.16.

The Engineer was selected using a formal request for qualifications process.

Fiscal Impact: Not to exceed an additional amount of \$190,000.00.

Explanation of Impact: If approved the below listed account could be reduced by an additional \$190,000.00.

THIS AMENDMENT is made and entered into this 19th day of June, 2008, by and between the City and County of Carson City, of the State of Nevada, hereinafter referred to as the "CITY", and Louis Berger Group, Inc., hereinafter referred to as the "CONSULTANT", and is made to amend the existing contract known as "CONTRACT #2002-002", and titled "Carson City Freeway - Phase 2 Utility Relocations"

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, CONSULTANT through no fault of his own has incurred additional elements of work required to complete the project which were not anticipated in the original scope of work. The work includes additional design effort, additional unexpected coordination with other utility relocations, additional unexpected reviews and review fees by NDEP, additional unanticipated coordination and multiple agreement documentation, redesign due to criteria and standard changes, and additional work for Cultural Resource Investigations.

WHEREAS, CITY and CONSULTANT desire to amend CONTRACT # 2002-002 to authorize CONSULTANT to perform the additional work and to compensate CONSULTANT for the additional work: and

WHEREAS, said amendment is at the request of both CITY and CONSULTANT, and that significant benefit will be derived by the City from said amendment;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutually promises contained herein, CITY and CONSULTANT, by and through their respective authorized representatives hereby agree to:

- 1 Amend Paragraph 1.1.1 of CONTRACT #2002-002 to provide in its entirety as follows:
 - 1.1.1 **CONSULTANT** shall provide and perform the following services as set forth in Exhibit A to this Amendment to CONTRACT #2002-002 attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference for and on behalf of **CITY** hereinafter referred to as "**Services**."
- 2 Amend Paragraph 2.1 of CONTRACT #2002-002 to provide in its entirety as follows:
 - 2.1 **CONSULTANT** shall complete the Scope of Work on or before October 30, 2008, as set forth in Exhibit A to this Amendment to CONTRACT #2002-002 attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference for and on behalf of **CITY** hereinafter referred to as "**Time of Completion**."
- 3 Amend Paragraph 3.2 of CONTRACT #2002-002 to provide in its entirety as follows:
 - 3.2 The parties agree that CONSULTANT will provide the Services specified in Article 1 Scope of Work and CITY agrees to pay CONSULTANT the CONTRACT SUM based upon time and materials and the attached fee schedule

Mr. Burnham:

The Louis Berger Group, Inc. (Berger) is submitting this proposal for an amendment to the Design Services Agreement for this project. This amendment addresses additional elements of work required to complete the project which were not anticipated in the original scope of work. The items of work requiring change to the project scope are:

- 1. Additional design effort to accommodate NDOT Carson City Freeway Project. Utility Clearance requirements.
- 2. Additional unexpected coordination with other utility relocations.
- 3. Additional unexpected reviews and review fees by NDEP Bureau of Safe Drinking Water.
- 4. Additional unanticipated coordination and multiple agreement documentation. packages for NDOT Right of Way for exceptions and agreements.
- 5. Redesign due to criteria and standard changes.
- 6. Additional work for Cultural Resource Investigations.

This amendment also reduces the scope of the Design Services Contract for Carson City Freeway Phase 2B to the status of the work performed to date, and coordination with Carson City Public Works or their assigned consultant to provide information on the preliminary water and sewer system relocation designs prepared by Berger.

Proposed Basis of Professional Services

Berger's proposed amendment to the scope of services is based on the existing contract for design services dated May 15, 2003 and last amended on February 15, 2005.

Additional Scope of Services

General

The amended Scope of Services for Berger to provide to CARSON CITY for this project are project management, sewer and water design, coordination, and permits. The additional level of effort for each task are proposed based on the attached estimates of manhours, direct costs, and sub-consultant fees.

Task 1 Project Management

This task includes additional work necessary to administer the activities, manage personnel and resources, monitor schedules and budgets, and coordinate with the City's Project and Construction Managers on a daily basis for the duration of the Project.

Task 2 Sewer Design Services

This work includes additional sanitary design services necessary to accommodate the changes in project utility accommodation criteria within NDOT Right of Way, prepare NDOT agreements, the preparation of NDOT Agreement requests, changes to City Standards, and sewer design changes as required to obtain NDEP Bureau of Safe Drinking Water approval of the sewer crossings of water facilities.

Task 3 Water Design Services

This task includes additional water design services necessary to accommodate the changes in project utility accommodation criteria within NDOT Right of Way, prepare NDOT agreements, the preparation of NDOT Agreement requests, changes to City Standards, and water design changes as required to obtain NDEP Bureau of Safe Drinking Water approval of the water crossings of sewer facilities.

Task 4 Additional Coordination

Additional unexpected coordination for this project includes:

- 1. Participation in additional NDOT/Carson City agreement meetings.
- 2. Coordination with NDOT Right of Way on behalf of Carson City Public Works.
- 3. Coordination with other utilities, review of utility permit drawings for conflicts with project designs. Assisting Carson City Public Works staff with other utility design reviews.
- 4. Additional agency coordination with NDEP Bureau of Safe Drinking Water, Water Quality, and Water Resources.
- 5. Additional coordination with US Corps of Engineers for Section 404 permitting of the proposed facilities.
- 6. Additional coordination with other City consultants for other portions of the work and other activities.

Task 5 Permits and Approvals

This task involves development of documents to facilitate the permitting and approvals of the project in multiple phases. These permits, certifications, approvals, and authorizations include NDOT Agreement Cost Estimates and Plans, NDOT Occupancy and Non-Revocable Occupancy Permits and updates, preliminary Temporary Work in Waterways permit, Section 401 Water Quality Certification, and approvals from the Bureau of Safe Drinking Water.

Task 6 Cultural Resources Investigation

This task involves the investigation necessary to clear additional project areas and storage areas of cultural resource significance to conform to NDOT agreement and permit requirements as previously negotiated.

Work Location

Berger assumes that most of the project consultant management meetings and DEPARTMENT project meetings will be held at The Louis Berger's Groups office or the CARSON CITY Public Works building in Carson City, by telephone or conference call. Berger assumes that on occasion meetings within the project area will be required. The Louis Berger Group will continue to perform most of the analysis and production work for assigned tasks from Berger's Las Vegas, Nevada office.

Additional Personnel

This amendment assigns Mr. Jimmy D. Roland, P.E. as Project Manager for the project and will be the Engineer of Record for the project designs.

Schedule

We are proposing to amend the existing contract for design services to end on September 2008.

Additional Fee

The proposed additional fee anticipated for this work as described is \$240,000.

The attached Contract Summary contains the estimate of consultant effort and fee detail.
