Staff Summary: City staff has applied for and received grant funding from the Carson Water Subconservancy District to perform activities connected to wetlands enhancement at the Fulstone Wetlands. The project site is located on Northridge Drive, across the street from the new Boys and Girls Club property. If the Board of Supervisors approves this interlocal contract, it will allow City staff to begin implementation of site improvements designed by Wood Rodgers, Inc. Explanation for Recommended Board Action: On October 19, 2006, the Board of Supervisors authorized

Explanation for Recommended Board Action: On October 19, 2006, the Board of Supervisors authorized a contract with Wood Rodgers, Inc., for rehabilitation of the existing wetlands located along Northridge Drive on the west side of the Carson City Freeway and along Lompa Lane on the east side of the Carson City Freeway. This rehabilitation project included improvements of hydrologic flow and the design of trails and signage. On October 4, 2007, and March 6, 2008, the Board of Supervisors approved amendments to the existing contract. These amendments were necessary due to the additional scope of work requested by staff, such as including the landscape component along Northridge Drive.

The Fulstone Wetlands, located on Northridge Drive and across the street from the new Boys and Girls Club property, has been identified as Phase I of the Wetlands Rehabilitation Project. A number of enhancements are planned at this site including trail improvements, sidewalk construction, revegetation, landscaping, site amenities, and interpretive signage. These grant funds from the Carson Water Subconservancy District will be used to fund activities connected to the wetlands enhancement and water quality improvement.

Explanation of Impact: Approval of this interlocal contract will provide Carson City with funds to begin site improvements at the Fulstone Wetlands. In addition, this grant requires no City funding to match the grant award.

INTERLOCAL CONTRACT

Addressing Funding From Subconservancy District
To Carson City for Wetlands Enhancement Phase 1
(Fulstone Wetlands) Project

THIS CONTRACT dated this _____ day of ______, 2008, is entered into by and between CARSON CITY, a political subdivision of the State of Nevada and the CARSON WATER SUBCONSERVANCY DISTRICT, a political subdivision of the State of Nevada (hereinafter "CWSD").

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, CARSON CITY is a governmental subdivision of the State of Nevada and therefore a public agency under NRS 277.100; and

WHEREAS, CWSD is a water subconservancy district created and organized under the provisions of Chapter 541 of NRS; and

WHEREAS, this Contract is entered into under the provisions of NRS 277.180 and accordingly must be ratified by appropriate official action of the governing body of each party as a condition precedent to its entry into force; and

WHEREAS, CARSON CITY is proposing to perform activities connected to the Wetlands Enhancement Phase 1 (Fulstone Wetlands) project; and described in Exhibit "A", attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference; and

WHEREAS, CWSD has agreed to set aside \$20,000.00 for fiscal year 2008-09 beginning July 1, 2008, and to grant CARSON CITY said amount in order to assist with the projects set forth in Exhibit "A".

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises and of the mutual covenants herein contained, it is mutually agreed by and between the parties as follow:

- CWSD hereby grants to CARSON CITY up to \$20,000.00 for fiscal year
 2008-09 beginning July 1, 2008, and to grant CARSON CITY said amount
 in order to assist with the projects set forth in Exhibit "A
- CARSON CITY will submit requests for funding periodically over the fiscal year. The request for funding shall be accompanied by a description of what the funds were used for and shall reference this Contract.
- CWSD commits to pay the approved amount of the request to CARSON
 CITY within four (4) weeks of said request.
- 4. CWSD shall have no responsibility for costs exceeding \$20,000.00.
- 5. This Contract shall terminate June 30, 2009, at which time CARSON CITY shall have one (1) month thereafter to submit its final invoice for payment related to work performed under this Contract.
- 6. The parties will not waive and intend to assert available NRS chapter 41 liability limitations in all cases. Contract liability of both parties shall not be subject to punitive damages. To the extent applicable, actual contract damages for any breach shall be limited by NRS 353.260 and NRS 354.626.
- 7. a. Consistent with paragraph 6 of this Contract, each party shall indemnify, hold harmless and defend, not excluding the others right to participate, the other party from and against all liability, claims, actions,

damages, losses, and expenses, including, but not limited to, reasonable attorneys fees and costs, arising out of any alleged negligent or willful acts or omissions of the indemnifying party, its officers, employees and agents. Such obligation shall not be construed to negate, abridge, or otherwise reduce any other right or obligation of indemnity which would otherwise exist as to any party or person described in this paragraph.

- b. The indemnification obligation under this paragraph is conditioned upon receipt of written notice by the indemnifying party within thirty (30) days of the indemnified party's accrual notice of any actual or pending claim or cause of action. The indemnifying party shall not be liable to hold harmless any attorneys' fees and costs for the indemnified party's chosen right to participate with legal counsel.

- 9. This Contract shall be by and between the parties hereto and shall not be assignable or transferable.
- 10. Any dispute regarding this Contract shall be decided according to the laws of the State of Nevada. If any part of this Contract is declared to be unlawful, any remaining obligations shall be deemed terminated.

- 11. This Contract may only be amended by consent of both parties. Any amendments must be written and executed with the same formality as this Contract.
- 12. This Contract constitutes the entire understanding between the parties and there are no representations, conditions, warranties or collateral agreements (expressed or implied), statutory or otherwise, with respect to the subject of this Contract.
- 13. This Contract becomes effective when it is ratified by the appropriate official action of the governing body of each party.
- 14. The parties hereto represent and warrant that the person executing this Contract on behalf of each party has full power and authority to enter into this Contract and that the parties are authorized by law to engage in cooperative action set forth herein.

 15. This Contract shall be entered into with duplicate originals, realizing that each entity, by necessity, must approve and execute the subject document at different dates, times and places.

PROJECT NAME: Carson City Wetlands Enhancement, Phase I (Fulstone wetlands)							

PROJECT LOCATION:

Carson City, Nevada. The Fulstone wetlands are located on the north side of Northridge Drive and west side U.S. Highway 395, across the street from the new Boys and Girls Club.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Briefly describe the project. Provide maps, drawings, photographs or other information. Additional sheets may be attached.

The Carson City Wetlands Enhancement project will provide measurable water quality improvement through wetland enhancement, creation, and management. Phase I is located across the street from the Boys and Girls Club (which will provide parking by prior agreement) and is adjacent to the Northridge Subdivision. This project consists of intensive wetland vegetation management to maintain and improve wetland functions for water quality improvement and mosquito control, revegetation treatment of adjacent upland buffer to reduce erosion potential and sediment source, trail enhancements and landscaping improvements. Existing vegetation management (weed abatement) and trash removal at the Northridge Subdivision culvert into the wetland will effectively enhance the wetland opportunity for stormwater runoff treatment by allowing flow to move through the wetlands. The Fulstone wetlands also provide access for short duration elementary school field trips, and more in-depth middle- and high-school science projects. Examples of possible educational activities include plant identification, water quality sampling, bird and insect surveys, and wildlife observations. A small kiosk or sign will be installed and describe the science of wetlands processes for water quality improvement.

PROJECT BENEFITS: Briefly describe the benefits to be realized if the project is implemented. Additional sheets may be attached.

The proposed project provides support in attaining objectives presented in the Carson River Stewardship Plan (May 2007). This plan identifies urban development as a potential source of non-point source pollution and the importance of functioning wetlands to alleviate such problems as well as provide many other environmental benefits. This project will assist in

alleviating non-point source pollutants from reaching the Carson River during flood events by providing upstream retention and treatment in a cost-effective manner. The Fulstone wetlands portion of the Hot Creek watershed is in an urban environment and it receives runoff from the Northridge subdivision and adjacent roadways containing pollutants such as sediment, organics, and oil and grease.

Additionally, the project has been designed to provide open space opportunities while preserving the natural elements of the site. One goal is to generate public interest and interaction by integrating the site into Boys and Girls Club after-school programs as well as local school outdoor education programs.
