# PROCLAMATION

## In Honor of Judge William A. Maddox

**WHEREAS**, Judge William A. Maddox graduated from Carson High School in 1965 and received a Bachelor of Arts Degree in Economics from Texas A&M University in 1969; and

**WHEREAS**, Judge Maddox served his country from 1969 through 1971 in the U.S. Army including a tour in Vietnam. He was awarded the Bronze Star, Air Medal, and Combat Infantry Badge with an honorable discharge; and

**WHEREAS**, after serving his country, Judge Maddox began employment with the California Department of Benefits from 1975 through 1977 as an Administrative Hearing Officer; and

**WHEREAS**, Judge Maddox continued his public service as a Deputy District Attorney for Carson City from 1978 through 1981; and

**WHEREAS**, Judge Maddox was elected as Carson City District Attorney from 1981 through 1985; and

**WHEREAS**, Judge Maddox served as the United States Attorney for the District of Nevada from 1985 through 1989 and as a Special Prosecutor for Douglas, Esmeralda, and Washoe Counties; and

**WHEREAS**, Judge Maddox entered private practice in 1989 where he acquired extensive trial experience and practiced law in the local to federal levels; and

**WHEREAS**, Judge Maddox returned to public service and was appointed District Court Judge of the First Judicial District Court in August, 2000. During his tenure, Judge Maddox was the visionary to consolidate administrative duties between the District Court and Carson City Justice/Municipal Court. Through this vision and support from the judges in these courts, the courts in Carson City have become more efficient.

**WHEREAS**, The Carson City Board of Supervisors wish to recognize the outstanding achievements of Judge William A. Maddox, and for his long standing public service to Carson City.
