Staff Summary: Pursuant to 7.030 of the Charter (the "Project Act"), the City is authorized to borrow money for any corporate purpose and to evidence such borrowing by the issuance of bonds or other securities pursuant to the Local Government Securities Law (being cited as Nevada Revised Statutes ("NRS") 350.500 through 350.720 (thee "Bond Act"); the Board of Supervisors (the "Board") proposes to acquire, construct, improve and equip drainage and flood control projects as defined in NRS 244A.027 (the "Projects"). The City reasonably expects to incur expenditures with respect to the Projects prior to the issuance of bonds for financing the Projects and to reimburse those expenditures from the issuance of bonds.

Summary - a resolution providing for the reimbursement of expenditures from the proceeds of drainage bonds.

RESOLUTION NO.

A RESOLUTION CONCERNING THE FINANCING OF DRAINAGE AND FLOOD CONTROL PROJECTS; PROVIDING FOR THE REIMBURSEMENT OF EXPENDITURES FROM THE PROCEEDS OF BONDS; AND PROVIDING THE EFFECTIVE DATE HEREOF.

WHEREAS, Carson City, in the State of Nevada (the "City" and "State," respectively), is organized and operating pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 213, Statutes of Nevada 1969 (the "Charter") and the general laws of the State; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 7.030 of the Charter (the "Project Act"), the City is authorized to borrow money for any corporate purpose and to evidence such borrowing by the issuance of bonds or other securities pursuant to the Local Government Securities Law (being cited as Nevada Revised Statutes ("NRS") 350.500 through 350.720 (the "Bond Act"); and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors (the "Board") proposes to acquire, construct, improve and equip drainage and flood control projects as defined in NRS 244A.027 (the "Projects"); and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF CARSON CITY, NEVADA:

Section 1. All action, proceedings, matters and things heretofore taken, had and done by the City, and the officers thereof (not inconsistent with the provisions of this resolution) directed toward the Projects and the financing thereof be, and the same hereby is, ratified, approved and confirmed.

Section 2. In order to permit the City to reimburse itself for prior expenditures relating to the Projects with the proceeds of bonds, the Board hereby determines and declares as follows:

	(a)	The City reasonably expects to incur expenditures with respect to the
Projects prior to the is	ssuance o	of bonds for financing the Projects and to reimburse those expenditures
from the issuance of	bonds; a	nd

(b) The maximum principal amount of drainage bonds expected to be issued is \$5,000,000. The maximum principal amount of drainage bonds expected to be used to reimburse such expenditures is \$2,000,000.

Section 3. All resolutions, or parts thereof, in conflict with the provisions of this resolution, are hereby repealed to the extent only of such inconsistency. This repealer shall not be constructed to revive any resolution, or part thereof, heretofore repealed.

Section 4. If any section, paragraph, clause or other provision of this resolution shall for any reason be held to be invalid or unenforceable, the invalidity or unenforceability of such section, paragraph, clause or other provision shall not affect any of the remaining provisions of this resolution.

Section 5. This resolution shall become effective and be in force immediately upon its adoption.
