**Subject Title:** Action to authorize the Open Space Manager to execute grant forms and an agreement between the U.S. Department of Agriculture Natural Resources Conservation Service and Carson City for the Carson City Erosion Control Project, Construction Phase #2.

**Staff Summary:** This grant will secure \$242,200 to be used by Carson City for drainages and flood mitigation improvements, in accordance with the City lands affected by the Waterfall Fire. The grantor will be the Natural Resources Conservation Service, and a match is not required. Funds must be obligated by September 30, 2009.

**Recommended Board Action:** I move to authorize the Open Space Manager to execute grant forms and an agreement between the U.S. Department of Agriculture Natural Resources Conservation Service and Carson City for the Carson City Erosion Control Project, Construction Phase #2.

**Explanation for Recommended Board Action:** In 2005, Mayor Teixeira and City Manager Linda Ritter were successful in obtaining through Senator Reid's office a grant for approximately \$309,000 for the rehabilitation of resources within private and City lands affected by the Waterfall Fire. The grant was used to assess the condition of the western watersheds in Carson City. The condition and proposed mitigation conceptual projects were previously adopted by the Board of Supervisors. The grant funds may be used for implementation or treatments, design and construction, implementation of vegetation treatments, and other measures within the limits of grant funding and as previously approved in the assessment and mitigation document prepared by Resource Concepts, Inc.
