1. Adjusted Modification Factors

Our actuary has recalculated and adjusted the PACT modification factors to be used effective July 1, 2009 through June 30, 2010. Your modification factor, based on historical payroll and losses incurred by your entity, for the next year is on the attached worksheet.

2. Classifications

The attached worksheet(s) list codes applicable to your entity effective July 1, 2009. Class code rates have decreased substantially for schools (-11%) and medical facilities (-23%), and by -4% for all other entities.

3. ACH Transfer Amount & Agent Compensation

The assessment due for the fourth quarter of fiscal year 2008-2009 will be adjusted based on the results of the payroll audit. You will be notified of the revised amount around the middle of May. At the same time, the amounts for the ACH transfer and agent compensation for the new fiscal year will be calculated.

4. Reminder – Police/Fire Retirees Heart Funding

Code 9999 uses the payroll total for your paid police and paid fire classifications as its rating basis. It is not subject to the experience modification factor (mod), agent fees, or any other service-related expenses.
