

TOTAL POOL EXPERIENCE


Frequency, the claims count for all members per year has averaged 492 per open year. Membership doubled since 1998, although claims activity appears to have stabilized over the open ten years. Open claims total 312 for the period or about 6% of all incidents and claims incurred.





Severity, based on total loss costs incurred without deduction for excess insurance or deductibles, has averaged \$4,381,481 with the worst year (2002) at \$9,114,251 comprising 19% of total costs for all years. Net of member deductibles and of excess insurance payments, the POOL's retained incurred claims averaged \$2,386,132. On a cost per claim basis the average net per claim cost is \$5,332.
