Recommended Board Action: Status report only, no action required. Staff will be soliciting input and direction from the Board of Supervisors.

Explanation of Recommended Board Action: Carson City Public Works staff and its consultant Black & Veatch, through extensive studies, have identified the quantity of water and water reserves that are necessary to support the community now and through ultimate build out of the City. Planning for and obtaining this water is further complicated by water quality issues, in particular the currently limited use of wells that are impacted by Uranium and Arsenic. The issues of quantity and quality will be resolved via a multifaceted water resource approach. These methods include regional cooperation for the delivery of Carson City owned water rights from neighboring counties, maximizing existing surface water resources (i.e., Marlette/Hobart) and a redesign of the distribution system that will provide for greater blending capabilities to resolve arsenic and uranium issues.
