NOTICE OF INTENTION TO ACT UPON A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE AN INSTALLMENT-PURCHASE AGREEMENT BY CARSON CITY, NEVADA

NOTICE is hereby given that the Board of Supervisors of Carson City, Nevada (the "Board" and "City", respectively) will hold a public hearing at a regular meeting to be held on Thursday, August 20, 2009 at the hour of 8:30 a.m. at the Community Center, 851 East William Street, Carson City, Nevada, to act upon a resolution authorizing an installment-purchase agreement with a maximum term of 20 years in the maximum principal amount of \$9,382,500 to enable the Board to pay all or a portion of the cost to acquire, improve and equip building projects as defined in NRS Section 244A.019 in the City.

The installment-purchase agreement is not proposed to be repaid in whole or in part by the levy of a tax which is exempt from the limitations on taxes ad valorem. The installment-purchase agreement is to be repaid from other legally available funds of the City, including, without limitation, monies in the City's Water Fund, Sewer Fund and General Fund in the estimated annual amount of \$200,000 to \$1,130,000 for a minimum period of 10 years and a maximum period of 20 years and other legally available monies, including ad valorem taxes levied within the limitations provided in Chapter 354 of the Nevada Revised Statutes.

The form of the resolution authorizing such installment-purchase agreement, to be considered by the Board after such hearing, and other information concerning such installment-purchase agreement and the purpose for which it is proposed to be used, may be examined in the office of the City Clerk, 2621 Northgate Lane, No. 56, Carson City, Nevada. All persons are invited to attend and to be heard regarding the proposed action. Prior to the hearing, written comments may be filed with the City Clerk at the aforementioned address.
