Carson Water Subconservancy District (CWSD) will give a presentation on Carson River Watershed regional activities. Part of the presentation will discuss the Comprehensive Regional Water Management Plan that CWSD is currently conducting. This plan includes evaluating future water supplies and demands for the various water purveyors in the watershed, changes in stream flow runoff patterns, evaluation of storage and lease programs, and water conservation. The presentation will also cover information regarding projects that are being implemented by the Carson River Coalition (CRC). The CRC consists of federal, state, local organizations, environmental groups, university representatives and private citizens. The CWSD is the host for the CRC and provides facilitation and coordination, grant administration and project management for CRC projects. The CRC has developed the Carson River Watershed Adaptive Stewardship Plan and the Regional Floodplain Management Plan and is in the process of implementing projects called for in these regional plans.
