Staff Summary: In preparation of taking ownership of numerous State streets, Carson City Public Works must purchase a snow blower to pick up snow from Carson Street and others as no storage space is available in the downtown corridors. This unit will also enable us to clear the business district more efficiently and provide a means to clear and widen the roads in higher elevations with less damage to curbs and other fixed facilities when necessary. It was originally planned to purchase the blower next year, however due to the long lead time, staff is recommending that the purchase be made now to ensure that the equipment is here for next year.



This includes providing and supporting the department's Equipment Management System (M5) and automated fueling system. The section provides fleet information products for the department as needed along with fleet training.

Equipment Purchasing

The Equipment Section is responsible for department equipment purchasing, that includes development of detailed technical specifications. Procurement contracts are prepared to not only serve Mn/DOT internal customers, but also other units of local government throughout Minnesota. This section also provides equipment sales, services for surplus and replaced used equipment.

AGENCY ORDERING INSTRUCTIONS. Orders are to be placed directly with the Contract Vendor. State agencies should use a Contract release order (CRO) or a blanket purchase order (BPC). The person ordering should include his or her name and phone number. Orders may be submitted via fax.

SCOPE. The purpose of the Contract is to provide a source for Snow Blowers, Engine Driven and Attachments.

SHIPPING REQUIREMENTS. All deliveries are to be FOB Destination. The Contract Vendor has stated the delivery charge per loaded mile and the delivery starting point on the Price Schedule. Mileage distance will be the distance from the delivery starting point to the purchaser's delivery point only. Mileage distances will be determined from calculations using "http://maps.yahoo.com". The ordering agency may use the Contract Vendor delivery, may pick up the equipment, or may contract for delivery with anyone it chooses.

DELIVERY REQUIREMENTS. The Contract Vendor must notify the receiving agency at least 72 hours before delivery to allow for inspection and compliance. 1.0 SCOPE

ENGINE DRIVEN SNOW BLOWER & ATTACHMENTS

This unit shall be the most current advertised production model as modified per specifications and approved by MN/DOT furnished with all standard equipment advertised whether or not specifically called for here except where the item is replaced by optional over standard equipment or conflicting equipment is specified. The unit shall be complete with all equipment required and ready for immediate operation to function as listed below. The unit must meet applicable codes and standards.

2.0 SNOW BLOWER REQUIREMENTS

- 2.1 Pricing will be accepted for snow blowers that have their own power source and are installed on loaders, tractor loader backhoes, industrial tractors.
- 2.2 Snow blowers must be complete and include all mounting hardware and controls so unit is complete ready to operate.
- 2.3 Price for base unit shall not include female coupler unit or standard hitch system. These items should be included in Section 5.0 as an option.
