Fiscal Impact: Total of \$373,336 - \$100,000 from the Q18/Quality of Life Fund, \$3,000 from the Stormwater Fund and \$270,336 from the General Fund. Because the grant requests for Nevada Day and Mile High Jazz Band are beneficial to the downtown (Redevelopment Area 1), the Board of Supervisors has directed staff to seek reimbursement from Redevelopment Funds of \$10,750 for Nevada Day and \$1,000 for Mile High Jazz Band.

Explanation of Impact: Per Board of Supervisors actions during FY 2010-11 budget process.

Funding Source: \$100,000 - Q18/Quality of Life Fund; \$3000 - Stormwater Fund; \$258,586 - General Fund; and, potentially \$11,750 - Redevelopment Fund.
