Subject Title: Action to approve and authorize the Mayor to sign an Easement Amendment between Nevada Division of State Lands and Carson City, whereby the Division of State Lands will grant the City an easement across the Carson River to facilitate access and maintenance of Lloyd's Bridge which was recently transferred to the City from NDOT. (Sharp)

Staff Summary: On May 28, 2009, the State of Nevada Department of Transportation (NDOT) relinquished ownership to Carson City a portion of Carson River Road including Lloyd's Bridge which crosses the Carson River. Because the Division of State Lands hold title to the bed and banks of the Carson River, an easement between the Division of State Lands and Carson City is required. The proposed Easement Amendment is essentially a transfer of property rights previously granted to NDOT.

EASEMENT AMENDMENT

THIS EASEMENT AMENDMENT, made and entered into this _____ day of _____, 2010, by and between the STATE OF NEVADA, acting through the DIVISION OF STATE LANDS, and the State Land Registrar, hereinafter referred to as GRANTOR and CARSON CITY, a Consolidated Municipality of the State of Nevada, hereinafter referred to as GRANTEE.

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the GRANTOR entered into an easement dated the 29th of March 1989, with the State of Nevada, acting by and through its DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION as the GRANTEE, for the purpose of a permanent easement and right-of-way for the bridge currently known as Lloyd's Bridge, lying upon, over and across portions of that certain property situated within the N ½ of Section 26, Township 15, Range 20 East, M.D.B.&M, Carson City, Nevada, as shown on Exhibit A, of recorded Document Number 85245, filed with the Carson City Recorder's Office on 5/9/1989; and

WHEREAS, on May 28, 2009 the DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION relinquished their easement interest and designated that certain right-of-way for a portion of Carson River Road including Lloyd's Bridge to CARSON CITY as recorded in Document Number 391154, filed with the Carson City Recorder's Office on 6/30/2009; and

WHEREAS, Attorney General's Opinion #204 dated April 20, 1976, concluded that "The State of Nevada owns the bed and shores of Lake Tahoe and other navigable bodies of water within Nevada to the present ordinary and permanent high water mark." Through formal court proceedings the Carson River has been determined to be a navigable body of water within Nevada; and

WHEREAS, GRANTEE, has made application to and wishes to obtain from the GRANTOR a Non-Exclusive Easement and right-of-way for Lloyd's Bridge to access and maintain as a designated road of the Carson City road system; and

WHEREAS, NRS 322.067 gives the Administrator of the Division of State Lands the authority to waive the fee for the grant of an easement to a local government for a public road.

WHEREAS, NRS 322.140 (1) allows the State Land Registrar to waive the fee for the issuance of this easement amendment since the right-of-way protects and/or promotes public health and/or safety.

NOW THEREFORE, GRANTOR agrees to amend the easement and right-of-way referenced above as recorded Document Number 85245 for the purpose of amending the GRANTEE from the State of Nevada, acting by and through its DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION to CARSON CITY, a Consolidated Municipality of the State of Nevada, to allow for access and maintenance purposes of Lloyd's Bridge as a designated road of the

Carson City road system as situated upon, over and across portions of that certain property lying within the North ½ of Section 26, Township 15 North, Range 20 East, M.D.B.&M., Carson City, Nevada; and more particularly described as a parcel of land lying within the average high water line of the Carson River, said parcel more fully described by metes and bounds as shown on EXHIBIT B, attached hereto and by reference made a part hereof.

GRANTEE, pursuant to 23 CFR Part 650 Subpart C of the National Bridge Inspection Standards, understands and agrees, the DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION, as federally required will perform an inspection of the easement and right-of-way for safety and evaluation purposes at the interval rate of no greater than once every twenty four (24) months.

GRANTEE, shall record this Easement Amendment at the Carson City Recorder's Office. All other terms and condition of the Easement Agreement remain in full force and effect, with no other changes or amendments thereto.
