1 - 3. CALL TO ORDER, ROLL CALL, AND PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE (9:00:59) - Mayor Crowell called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m. Roll was called; a quorum was present. Supervisor Aldean was absent. Supervisor Williamson led the pledge of allegiance.

4. ADOPTION OF AGENDA (9:01:50) - Mayor Crowell entertained requests to modify the agenda and, when none were forthcoming, deemed it adopted.

5. PUBLIC COMMENTS AND DISCUSSION (9:01:58) - Mayor Crowell entertained public comment; however, none was forthcoming.

6. CLERK / RECORDER - ACTION TO APPROVE THE CANVASS OF THE VOTE AS PRESENTED BY THE CLERK / RECORDER FOR THE 2010 PRIMARY ELECTION (9:02:14) - Mayor Crowell introduced this item. Mr. Glover reviewed the canvass of the 2010 primary election, copies of which he distributed to the Board members and staff prior to the start of the meeting. He responded to questions of clarification relative to the statistical information included in the canvass.

Mr. Glover thanked Chief Deputy Elections Clerk Sue Merriwether, Management Assistant Sylvia Yasumoto, Office Support Technician Beth Phelps, all of the election workers, volunteers, and Parks Department staff. Mr. Glover advised that the primary election had 6.5 percent more voters than any election since 1992. There was a 51.58 percent voter turnout, and he anticipates a voter turnout in the "high 80 percent" for the general election.

Mayor Crowell commended Mr. Glover on a job well done. Supervisor Livermore commended the election workers' uniforms. Mr. Glover provided background information, and noted the importance of easily identifiable election workers who can immediately address voter problems and issues. Supervisor Walt commended Mr. Glover on a well-organized primary election, and requested him to convey the Board's appreciation to his Elections Division staff. Supervisor Williamson also commended the primary election
