- Regular meetings of the board of supervisors shall be held in Carson City on the first and third Thursdays in each calendar 1. month, unless such day falls on a holiday or on a nonjudicial day, in which event the regular meeting shall be held on the immediately following judicial day. By a motion made in a property noticed meeting, the board may take action to change the date of a regularly scheduled future board meeting if the board finds that it is in the best interest of the public and if the board acts to change the meeting date at least twenty (20) days before the date of the meeting to be changed.
- The official meeting place of the board of supervisors is the Sierra Room, Carson City Community Center, 851 E. Williams 2. Street, Carson City, Nevada.
- The board of supervisors may hold additional regular, work session or special meetings during a calendar month as needed 3. and may specify the time, place and purpose of the meeting in the meeting notice.
- Nothing contained in this section prohibits the board of supervisors from recessing a regularly scheduled meeting and continuing such meeting to a later time and place certain, provided such time and place are indicated in an appropriate motion made during the regularly scheduled meeting.
- The dates of the regular meetings of the board of supervisors for the month of January, 1997 are January 9th and January 5. 23rd.
