Subject Title: Action to adopt a resolution approving the expenditure of \$106,255 from the Revolving Fund for the Redevelopment Agency to support the Arlington Square Ice Rink. (Roger Moellendorf)

PURSUANT TO NRS 279.628(2), THIS RESOLUTION MUST BE APPROVED BY A 2/3rds VOTE OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS.

Staff Summary: This request is to expend \$106,255 from the Revolving Fund for the Redevelopment Agency to support The Arlington Square Ice Rink. Opening Wednesday, November 24, 2010, and running through Saturday, January 22, 2011, the holiday season ice skating venue in Downtown Carson City is located in the Carson Nugget's parking lot on Carson and Robinson Streets, and becomes an ice skating venue.

Recommended Board Action: I move to adopt a resolution approving the expenditure of \$135,405 from the Revolving Fund for the Redevelopment Agency to support the Arlington Square Ice Rink.

Explanation for Recommended Board Action: This action would approve the expenditure requested and make the findings required for the expenditure. This update to the RDA includes details on the installation, partnerships, promotions, outreach, budget, and operations of the project. NRS 279.628 permits the expenditure of money from the redevelopment revolving fund for the purpose of any expenses necessary of incidental to the carrying out of the redevelopment plan adopted by the Carson City Board of Supervisors. Prior to approving the expenditure, the Board of Supervisors must make the findings that there is a causal connection between this redevelopment effort and the need for the expenses, the expenses are needed to ensure the success of the redevelopment plan, and that the amount of the expenses to be given are minor in comparison to the money required for the overall redevelopment plan. The action is requested of the Redevelopment Authority to recommend to the Board of Supervisors the approval of this expenditure.

The Redevelopment Plan adopted by the Carson City Board of Supervisors provides that a purpose of the Plan is to "encourage and assist in providing 'people oriented areas' in the Downtown for daytime and evening special events and promotional activities," and "establish the highest level of

recreational opportunity for residents and visitors of all age levels." Based upon the last two last years, the Arlington Square Ice Rink attracts thousands to our Downtown during times that are otherwise quiet and inactive. The increased foot traffic generated by the Arlington Square Ice Rink within this "people oriented area" has a direct impact on the success of many small businesses and cultural facilities throughout the area. Thus, there is a causal connection between this redevelopment effort and the need for the expenses. Additionally, these expenses are needed to ensure the success of the redevelopment plan, as this finding specifically pays for the professional installation, operations, marketing, and management of the rink. Finally, this funding is incidental to the overall cost of implementing the redevelopment plan. The amount requested \$106,255 is essential to ensuring the successful operation.

Applicable Statue, Code, Policy, Rule or Regulation: NRS 279.382 – 279.685

Fiscal Impact: \$135,405 allocated in redevelopment's budget. We project that the City will generate approximately \$15,000 in additional food and beverage tax and \$10,000 in additional sales tax from the anticipated \$1,500,000 in new economic activity. The staging of this event will produce this new economic activity not only within the Downtown, but throughout the entire community. Staff continues to evaluate the funding needs and economic impacts the wintertime activity.
