- 1. Promote, develop, fund, construct, and market trails and associated facilities that provide running, biking, walking, and aquatic opportunities and events.
 - Example: Complete and submit an application to achieve a "Runner Friendly Community" for Carson City.
- 2. Promote healthy lifestyle programs by collaborating with other organizations and agencies.
 - Example: Investigate into participating in First Lady Michelle Obama's "Lets Move" program.
- 3. Review and prioritize Quality of Life capital projects and make recommendations to the Board of Supervisors.
- 4. Continue to support a Volunteer Coordinator position within the Parks and Recreation Department that would have little or no financial impact to the City.
 - Example: Investigate a college work study or intern program or advertise for experienced volunteers.
- 5. Continue to encourage neighborhood volunteer programs and projects as well as the Adopt-A-Park program.
