**NOTICE OF HEARING AND OF INTENTION TO
AUTHORIZE A
MEDIUM TERM OBLIGATION BY THE CITY OF
CARSON CITY, NEVADA**

Notice is hereby given that the Board of Supervisors of the City of Carson City, Nevada (the "Board" and "City", respectively) will hold a public hearing at a regular meeting to be held at 8:30 a.m. on Thursday, May 17, 2012 in the Community Center Sierra Room, 851 East William Street, Carson City, Nevada, to act upon a resolution authorizing a medium-term obligation of the City in the maximum principal amount of \$1,100,000 to enable the Board to finance the cost of ambulances, wheel chair vans, and improvements and equipment for the City land fill (the "Project").

The medium-term obligation is not proposed to be repaid in whole or in part by the levy of a tax exempt from the limitations on taxes ad valorem, but is to be repaid from legally available funds of the City, including, without limitation, monies deposited in the City's capital projects fund in an estimated annual amount of \$233,500, and other legally available monies, including ad valorem taxes levied within the limitations provided in Chapter 354 of the Nevada Revised Statutes.

The form of the resolution authorizing such medium-term obligation to be considered by the Board after such hearing, and other information concerning such medium-term obligation and the purpose for which it is proposed to be used, may be examined in the Office of the City Clerk, 201 North Carson Street, Suite 1, Carson City, Nevada. All persons are invited to attend and be heard regarding the proposed action. Prior to the hearing, written comments may be filed with the City Clerk at the aforementioned address.
