- **1 3. CALL TO ORDER, ROLL CALL, PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE** (9:01:52) Mayor *Pro Tem* Aldean called the meeting to order at 9:01 a.m. Roll was called; a quorum was present. Mayor Crowell was absent. At Mayor *Pro Tem* Aldean's request, Geoff Dornan led the pledge of allegiance.
- **4. PUBLIC COMMENTS AND DISCUSSION** (9:02:57) Mayor *Pro Tem* Aldean entertained public comment; however, none was forthcoming.
- 5. POSSIBLE ACTION TO ADOPT THE AGENDA (9:03:25) Mayor *Pro Tem* Aldean entertained a motion to adopt the agenda. Supervisor Walt so moved. Supervisor Abowd seconded the motion. Motion carried 4-0.
- 6. CLERK / RECORDER POSSIBLE ACTION TO APPROVE THE CANVASS OF THE VOTE AS PRESENTED BY THE CLERK / RECORDER FOR THE 2012 PRIMARY ELECTION (9:03:41) Mayor *Pro Tem* Aldean introduced this item. Ms. Merriwether reviewed the agenda materials, the Abstract of the Vote, the corresponding statistical information, and responded to questions of clarification with regard to the same. She commended the regular Elections Division staff and the election workers on a job well done. She acknowledged that the three votes which were not signed for did not change any election results. Mayor *Pro Tem* Aldean noted that Carson City's voter turnout was the highest in the State, at 34.15 percent.

Mayor *Pro Tem* Aldean congratulated the winners of the primary election, and commended Maurice White on a well-run campaign. Mayor *Pro Tem* Aldean entertained a motion. **Supervisor Abowd moved to approve the canvass of the vote for the 2012 primary election, as presented by the Clerk-Recorder. Supervisor Walt seconded the motion.** Mayor *Pro Tem* Aldean entertained public comment and, when none was forthcoming, called for a vote on the pending motion. **Motion carried 4-0.** Supervisor McKenna thanked all the candidates who ran in the primary election. "You've enhanced the community just by sharing your ideas."
