Subject Title: For Possible Action: To adopt Resolution No. _____ and approve the removal of timed parking zones for one block on the west side of North Plaza Street between East Telegraph Street and the abandoned section of East Spear Street. (Patrick Pittenger)

Staff Summary: The Public Works Department has received requests from employees of the Nevada Commission on Tourism located on North Plaza Street to remove the two-hour parking zones on the west side of the street.

Recommended Board Action: I move to adopt Resolution No. _____ and approve the removal of timed parking zones for one block on the west side of North Plaza Street between East Telegraph Street and the abandoned section of East Spear Street.

Explanation for Recommended Board Action: Employees of the Nevada Commission on Tourism have requested that the two-hour parking zones on the west side of North Plaza Street immediately adjacent to their offices be removed. Public Works staff surveyed the owners of several businesses in the vicinity, including the Carson Nugget Casino, and there was support for the proposed removal of the timed parking zones at this location. Due to the nature of the business immediately adjacent to the west side of North Plaza Street, and relatively ample parking at the Carson Nugget Casino and surrounding surface streets, staff is recommending that the Board approve the removal of the timed parking zones.

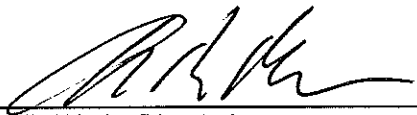

A RESOLUTION AMENDING PAGE 21 OF THE ATTACHMENT TO RESOLUTION NO. 1989-R-43 TO EXCLUDE THE WEST SIDE OF NORTH PLAZA STREET BETWEEN EAST TELEGRAPH STREET TO THE SOUTH AND THE ABANDONED EAST SPEAR STREET TO THE NORTH FROM PREVIOUSLY ESTABLISHED TIMED PARKING ZONES.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 1989-R-43, the Board of Supervisors resolved to approve maps depicting controlled parking zones on several streets within Carson City; and

WHEREAS, Carson City staff received requests to remove timed parking zones on North Plaza Street between East Telegraph Street and the abandoned East Spear Street; and

WHEREAS, Carson City staff surveyed businesses in the vicinity of the proposed removal of timed parking zones; and

WHEREAS, businesses in the vicinity of the proposed removal of timed parking zones unanimously supported the proposed action; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 10.24.210 of the Carson City Municipal Code, (1) The board may erect official traffic control devices regulating the stopping, standing or parking of vehicles on any highway under its jurisdiction, and (2) Whenever devices are erected giving notice thereof, it is unlawful for any person to stop, stand or park a vehicle for longer than the time designated by any such sign; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 10.24.305 of the Carson City Municipal Code, (1) In controlled parking zones, the board shall cause time limit signs to be installed in such numbers and at such locations as in its judgment may be necessary for the regulation, control and inspection of the parking of vehicles therein, including the reservation of loading zones for commercial vehicles, and (2) The board shall by resolution fix the time limitations for legal parking in such zones and the hours during the day when the time limitations shall be effective, in compliance with the provisions of this title, and shall indicate the time limitations by causing the same to be designated on the appropriate signs posted in said zone.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that Resolution No. 1989-R-43 is hereby amended to remove timed parking zones on the west side of North Plaza Street between East Telegraph Street and the abandoned East Spear Street.
