Staff Summary: Fees for permits issued by Carson City Health and Human Services Environmental Health Program have historically been calculated based on the whole facility, and not the individual permitted area. This update would allow for all permits issued by Carson City Health and Human Services Environmental Health Program to be charged for, and would be a consistent methodology with surrounding health authorities. These updates also add charges for plan reviews of commercial and residential building permits. The charges for residential well and septic are in other chapters of Carson City Municipal Code; this update would bring all the fees charged by Carson City Health and Human Services, Environmental Health Program into one chapter. New fees that would be charged would include Invasive Body Decoration and Child Cares. Historically these types of permitted establishments have not been charged a fee for the permit issued by the Environmental Health Program.

An internal comparison study of the fees included fees charged by the State of Nevada, Washoe County District Health Department and Southern Nevada Health District. Fees that would be charged with this change would be lower than the surrounding health authorities in Nevada.

Explanation for Recommended Board Action: Charging fees for individual permits issued by the Environmental Health Program would create a consistent methodology of charging fees for all permits issued by the Program. Adding all currently charged Environmental Health Program fees to one Chapter will establish one complete fee schedule for the Program to use.

Applicable Statue, Code, Policy, Rule or Regulation NRS 237 regarding business impact statements.

Fiscal Impact: We estimate an increase in the amount of fees collected for permits issued.

Explanation of Impact: With the passing of this ordinance, permit holders will be charged per permit, the amount of fees paid will increase.

Funding Source: Fees paid by permit holders, contractors, and general fund.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CARSON CITY MUNICIPAL CODE TITLE 9. HEALTH AND WELFARE, CHAPTER 9.04 - HEALTH DIVISION PERMITS AND FEE SCHEDULE, AMENDING SECTION 9.04.010 - DEFINITIONS TO CLARIFY AND EXPAND DEFINITIONS AND ADD A DEFINITION OF INVENTORY, AMENDING SECTION 9.04.020 - PERMITS REQUIRED. UPDATING THE LANGUAGE OF THE SECTION TO CLARIFY THE TYPE OF HEALTH PERMITS THAT ARE ISSUED - AMENDING SECTION 9.04.030 -DUTIES OF THE PERMIT HOLDER, TO CLARIFY LANGUAGE, AMENDING SECTION 9.04.040 - PERMITS, APPROVALS AND OTHER REQUIREMENTS, TO CLARIFY LANGUAGE UPDATE, UPDATE FEE LANGUAGE, ADD FEES FROM TITLE 12 INTO TITLE 9, AMENDING SECTION 9.04.050 -REVOCATION OR SUSPENSION, TO CLARIFY LANGUAGE, AMENDING SECTION 9.04.060 - PENALTIES, ADDITION OF LANGAGE FROM SECTION 9.04.065. DELETING SECTION 9.04.065- ADDITIONAL FEES. DELETING SECTION 9.04.070 SEVERABILITY AND OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATED THERETO.

THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF CARSON CITY DO ORDAIN:

Section I: Title 9, Chapter 9.04 of the Carson City Municipal code is hereby amended as follows:

Chapter 9.04 - HEALTH DIVISION PERMITS AND FEE SCHEDULE

Sections:

9.04.010 - Definitions.

9.04.020 - Permits required.

9.04.030 - Duties of the permit holder.

9.04.040 - Permits, approvals and other requirements.

9.04.050 - Revocation or suspension.

9.04.060 - Penalties.

9.04.065 Additional fees. Reserved.

9.04.070 Severability. Reserved.

<u>Section II:</u> Title 9, Chapter 9.04.010 of the Carson City Municipal Code is hereby amended as follows:

9.04.010 - Definitions.

The following definitions shall apply throughout this chapter unless a different meaning is clearly indicated by the context or is stated in any of the several sections:

- 1. "Approval" means acceptable to [the department] Carson City Health & Human Services and so stated in writing, by permit, or indicated by stamp or seal.
- 2. ["Department" (CCHD)] "CCHHS" means [the Carson City health department] Carson City Health & Human Services.
- 3. "Health authority" [means the health officer of the Carson City health department or his orher designee] means the officers and agents of the local Board of Health.
- [4. "Permit" means a written permit, stamp or seal of approval issued by the Carson City health department]
- 4. "Health officer" means the person who is named as the city physician and who is learned in sanitary science, public health practice and the diagnosis of infectious diseases
- [5. "Person" includes any natural individual, firm, trust, partnership, association, institution, corporation, or any other business entity and includes the plural as well as the singular, feminine as well as the masculine.]
- 5. "Inventory" means any area of operation that is inspected and permitted by the Carson City Health & Human Services based on the risk to public health.
- [6. "Sanitary code" means all of the rules and regulations pertaining to health, sanitation and environment which are adopted by the board of health of Carson City, or the state of Nevada.]
- 6. "Permit" means a written permit, stamp or seal of approval issued by the Carson Health & Human Services.
- [7. "Health officer" means the person who is named as the city physician and who is learned in sanitary science, public health practice and the diagnosis of infectious diseases.]
- 7. "Person" includes any natural individual, firm, trust, partnership, association, institution, corporation, or any other business entity and includes the plural as well as the singular, feminine as well as the masculine.
- 8 "Sanitary Code" means all of the rules and regulations pertaining to health, sanitation and environment which are adopted by the board of health of Carson City.

<u>Section III</u>: Title 7, Chapter 9.04.020 of the Carson City Municipal Code is hereby amended as follows:

9.04.020 - Permits required.

A health permit is required for the following establishments, businesses or activities:

- [a. Food Service Establishments, Bars, Mobile Catering—Retail and Wholesale, Grocers and Markets, Bakeries, Produce Stands and Temporary Food Establishments. All establishments preparing, serving, selling or delivering food or drink for human consumption shall have a health permit as required by this title before beginning any operation, and shall be inspected in accordance with state of Nevada Regulations Governing the Sanitation of Food Establishments, Mobile Food and Drink, and Servicing Depots and the Carson City Municipal Code.]
- a. Food establishment inventories preparing, serving, selling or delivering food or drink for human consumption shall have a health permit as required by this title before beginning any operation, and shall be inspected accordingly, including, but not limited to, Convenience Stores, Retail Groceries, Ice Cream Shops, Retail Food Producers, Bakeries, Wholesale Distributing, Restaurants, Coffee Carts, Vending Machine Companies, Meat Departments, Bars and Lounges, Produce Departments, Seafood Departments, Mobile Ice Cream, Snow Cone Vehicles, Deli Departments, Child Care with Food Service, Mobile Food Vehicles, Caterers, Continental Breakfasts, Bed and Breakfasts, Take Outs, School Cafeterias and other fee exempt establishments, and Temporary Food Establishments.
- b. [The state of Nevada Rules and Regulations for Child Care Facilities Regulations Governing Services and Facilities for Children (NAC 432A) are adopted as part of the Carson City health code.] Commercial and home child care facility inventories shall have a health permit as required by this title before beginning any operation, and shall be inspected annually[—at least every six (6) months for conformance with these rules and regulations.] in accordance with NAC 432A.260. [All applicants for a permit to operate a child care facility must undergo a basic sheriff's investigation, and must pay the sum of twenty five dollars (\$25.00) for the cost of the investigation.]
- c. Public accommodation inventories [includes] including hotels[,] and motels [and roominghouses or boardinghouses] which provide accommodations to the transient public shall have a health permit as required by this title before beginning any operation, and shall be inspected on an annual basis in accordance with [the state of Nevada Law Governing Sanitation and Safety of Hotels and Public Accommodations (] NRS 447 and NAC 447 [), as amended.]
- d. [Trailer Parks, Mobilehome Parks, Recreational Vehicle Parks. Any park] Mobile home park and recreational vehicle park[s which are any park] inventories renting space for temporary or permanent parking of a mobile home, trailer or recreational vehicle shall have a health permit as required by this title before beginning any operation, and shall be inspected on an annual basis in accordance with [the state of Nevada Regulations Governing Mobile Home and Mobilehome Parks, and regulations governing Sanitation Facilities for Camping Vehicles.] NRS 461A and NAC 461A.
- e. Public bathing places inventories including [Swimming] swimming pools, hot springs, and spas shall have a health permit as required by this title before beginning any operation, and shall be inspected [monthly during months of operation] at least once a

season in accordance with the Carson City Municipal Code and [the state of Nevada Regulations Governing Public Bathing Places.] NRS 444.050-444.120 and NAC 444.010-444.546

- f. Invasive body decoration inventories including tattoo, body piercing and permanent cosmetic operations shall have a health permit as required by this title before beginning any operation, and shall be inspected on an annual basis in accordance with the Carson City Municipal Code.
- g. Public institution inventories including public and private elementary, middle, and high schools, shall have a health permit as required by this title before beginning any operation, and shall be inspected on a biannual basis in accordance with NRS 444.330-444.335 and NAC 444.568–444.56862.
- h. Bottled water plant inventories shall have a health permit as required by this title before beginning any operation, and shall be inspected on an annual basis in accordance with NAC 445A.544-445A.590.
- i. Jail and detention center inventories shall have a health permit as required by this title before beginning any operation, and shall be inspected on an annual basis in accordance with NAC 211.

<u>Section IV</u>: Title 9, Chapter 9.04.030 of the Carson City Municipal Code is hereby amended as follows:

9.04.030 - Duties of the permit holder.

The owner, person in charge or control, or the lessee, [tenant or occupant] of every [building,] inventory, establishment, premises, place, potable water supply, sewerage or drainage system has the duty to and shall keep, place and preserve the same in such condition, and to conduct and maintain the same in such manner, that it shall not be dangerous to the public health or in violation of the rules and regulations of the [sanitary code] Sanitary Code.

<u>Section V</u>: Title 9, Chapter 9.04.040 of the Carson City Municipal Code is hereby amended as follows:

9.04.040 - Permits, approvals and other requirements.

1. No person shall engage in one (1) of the activities enumerated in Section 9.04.020 without first obtaining a permit from the [CCHD or by submission of plot plans or construction

drawings, and shall be completed in all pertinent details] CCHHS unless permitted under another governmental public health agency.

- 2. Permit applications shall be made on forms provided by the [CCHD] CCHHS or by submission of plot plans or construction drawings, and shall be completed in all pertinent details.
- 3. No application for permit shall receive approval until a complete health inspection has been made and all deficiencies corrected. The applicant shall demonstrate to the [CCHD] CCHHS compliance with all pertinent state and municipal health laws, regulations and ordinances before a permit will be issued.
- 4. In cases where the submission of plans and/or specifications is required, no construction, modification or adaptation shall commence, except that required to eliminate, remove or minimize imminent or immediate danger to the public health and well-being, unless the required plans have been approved. Construction shall be in conformance with the approved plans and specifications.
- 5. The approval of plans and specifications shall lapse and become invalid one (1) year from the date of approval if the majority (one-half (1/2) or more) portion of the work described in the plans and specifications has not commenced by such anniversary date.
- 6. Permits are valid for one (1) year from the date of issuance thereof unless suspended or revoked by the [CCHD] CCHHS for violation of the [health code] Sanitary Code. Each inventory is to be charged separately. Fees collected for such permits are not refundable. No permit is transferable from person to person or place to place.
- 7. Every permit must at all times be kept on the premises or in the vehicle designated and displayed in a conspicuous manner therein. [When practicable, permits shall be framed and protected against soiling and shall be available for inspection by the department or the public.]
- 8. No permit shall be issued and no permit is valid until the bona fide permit fee is received by the [CCHD] CCHHS or its designated representative:
 - a. By cash, check, money order, credit card or cashier check to the CCHD CCHHS or its designated representative at the time of application.
 - b. Once an operator of a [property] properly licensed business within Carson City has been issued a health [permit] permits, billing for [permit fee] fees to cover a subsequent year will be mailed prior to the expiration date of [such] each permit. Payment for the health [permit] permits must be made prior to issuance of any business license. Fees shall be paid according to the following schedule:

No person shall refuse to allow the [CCHD] CCHHS to inspect fully any and all premises of acilities at any reasonable time, and no person shall interfere with the [CCHD] CCHHS on the discharge of its duties whether in inspections for application approval or for the enforcement of the sanitary code. Refusal to allow inspection or interference with the [CCHD] CCHHS shall be grounds for refusal of a permit.
- 11. Anyone agrieved by the refusal to grant a permit may within five (5) days of such refusal apreal in writing to the Carson City board of supervisors which shall conduct a hearing the eon.

<u>Se</u> tion VI: Title : , Chapter 9.04 050 of the Carson City Municipal Code is hereby amended as follows:

9.0 1.050 - Rev. ation or suspension.

- 1. Permits issted under the provisions of this chapter may be suspended temporarily by the [GCHD] CCHH for failure of the holder to comply with the requirements of this chapter. Whenever a permit holder is found to be in noncompliance with the provisions of this chapter, the permit holder shall be given a written notice thereof, such written notice to specify in detail the corrective reseasures necessary to bring the permit holder back into compliance, and a time period for implementation.
- 2. Any person whose permit has been suspended may, at any time, make application for a reinspection for the purpose of reinstatement of the permit. Within ten (10) days following receipt of a written request, including a statement signed by the applicant that the conditions causing the summer of the permit have been corrected, [the department] CCHHS shall make a reinspection. If the applicant is complying with the requirements of this chapter, the permit shall be a instated.
- 3. For seriou or releated violations of any of the requirements of this chapter or for the interference with the ICCHD] I CHHS in the performance of its duties, the permit may be permanently releated following an opportunity for a hearing before the board of supervisors. An permit hold who se permit is being considered for revocation shall be notified by certified milk, return recent requested. The permit shall be permanently revoked at the end of five (5) days following to adata of service of such notice, unless a request for a hearing is filled with the [department] Could be with the control of th

Consolidated Municipality of Carson City BUSINESS IMPACT STATEMENT

The following business impact statement was prepared pursuant to NRS 237.090 to address the proposed impact of adopting:

- (a) An amendment to Carson City Municipal Code Title 9, Health and Welfare, Chapter 9.04-Health Division Permits and Fee Schedule.
- The following constitutes a description of the manner in which comment was
 solicited from affected businesses and an explanation of the manner in which other
 interested persons may obtain a copy of the proposed changes, and a copy of the
 Business Impact Statement; the Consolidated Municipality of Carson City received
 multiple responses in relation to the proposed rule. The summary of the question
 received is also provided in this section.

A. Notice

A notice was mailed to all permit holders about the proposed fee changes. The notice included a letter inviting the permit holders to a meeting at the Community Center,\ on March 7, 2013; the notice also included a copy of the proposed changes to Carson City Municipal Code Title 9. In addition, the notice also provided information to the permit holder on how to contact Carson City Health and Human Services if they were not able to attend the informational meeting. The notice and supporting materials were also sent to Carson City Chamber of Commerce. The Chamber sent out the notice and supporting materials via email to all of their members on several occasions. Carson City Health and Human Services also posted on their website www.gethealthycarsoncity.org a copy of the notice and supporting materials. Carson City Health and Human Services also deployed an online survey to capture comments for the Business Impact Statement. A copy of the notice and the supporting materials were also sent to the Nevada Appeal. Nevada Appeal produced two articles about the proposed fee changes, one on March 2, 2013, the other on March 9, 2012.

B. Summary of Comments

Comments were open until March 22, 2013.

Common concerns expressed by permit holders were: How much would my new fees total?; Could the number of permits currently issued be fine-tuned?; When would the new fees be implemented?; and How are seats in common areas counted towards the total number of seats in the permitted establishment?

2. The estimated economic effect of the proposed rule on the businesses, including, without limitation, both adverse and beneficial effects, and both direct and indirect

effects:

Adverse effects: The increase in fees would have a financial impact on some businesses.

Beneficial effects: It is anticipated that the proposed changes in Title 9 will establish a fair methodology of charging for permits issued by the Environmental Health Program.

Direct effects: The passage of these amendments will allow the Environmental Health Program to charge more appropriately for the number of permits issued by the program.

Indirect effects: The passing of this measure may have indirect effects, however at this time, those effects cannot be quantified.

3. The following constitutes a description of the methods that the governing body of the local government considered to reduce the impact of the proposed rule on businesses and a statement regarding whether any, and if so which, of these methods were used:

Staff recommends that existing permit holders to be billed for the new fees at their next billing cycle, to reduce the immediate impact of any increase in health permit fee. This provides businesses the ability to plan their budgets at least 6 months before the increase. If passed, new permits issued would be charged according to the new methodology.

4. The governing body estimates the annual cost to the local government for enforcement of the proposed rule is:

There will be limited impact to the governing body in the implementation of the new fee schedule. Currently all permit holders receive a bill; however, the billing documents would need to be updated to reflect the proposed changes.

5. The governing body estimates the total amount of new fees collected to be:

Staff estimates that the new fees collected would approximately amount to \$51,000. These fees would go to the general fund; the same fund to which the current fees collected go.

6. The proposed rule includes provisions, which duplicate or are more stringent than federal, state or local standards regulating the same activity. The following explains why such duplicative or more stringent provisions are necessary.

The proposed change is not duplicative; however, it will assist in recuperating some of the costs related to services provided by the Consolidated Municipality of Carson City that are required as a direct impact of the businesses that are regulated by the proposed rule.

OBJECTION PROCESS

- If a business believes it is aggrieved by a rule (as defined in NRS 237.060)
 adopted by the governing body, the business may object by filing a petition in
 writing with the clerk/secretary of the local government at 201 North Carson
 Street, Ste. 1, Carson City, Nevada 89701.
- 2. The governing body will accept such petitions for a period of thirty (30) days following approval of the subject Rule for one of the following reasons:
 - a. The governing body failed to prepare a business impact statement as required pursuant to NRS chapter 237; or
 - b. The business impact statement prepared by the governing body did not consider or significantly underestimated the economic effect of the ordinance or rule on business.
- Upon receipt of the petition, the clerk/secretary will forward a copy to the local government's attorney, the department/agency that generated the Rule and the local government's manager/chief executive.
- 4. Staff will consider the merits of the petition and forward a recommendation to the governing body.
- 5. The governing body will determine if the petition has merit and direct staff accordingly.
- 6. A sample petition is attached.

PETITION OBJECTING TO ADOPTION OF RULE

NRS 237.100 provides that a business that is aggrieved by an ordinance, regulation, resolution or other type of instrument through which a governing body exercises legislative powers, except pursuant to Chapter 271, 278, 278A and 278B of NRS (herein a "Rule") adopted by the governing body may object to all or a part of the Rule by filing a petition. Section II: Title 9, Chapter 9.04.010 of the Carson City Municipal Code is hereby amended as follows:

9.04.010 - Definitions.

The following definitions shall apply throughout this chapter unless a different meaning is clearly indicated by the context or is stated in any of the several sections:

- 1. "Approval" means acceptable to <u>Carson City Health & Human Services</u> and so stated in writing, by permit, or indicated by stamp or seal.
- 2. "CCHHS" means Carson City Health & Human Services.
- 3. "Health authority" means the officers and agents of the local Board of Health.
- 4. "Health officer" means the person who is named as the city physician and who is learned in sanitary science, public health practice and the diagnosis of infectious diseases
- <u>5.</u> <u>"Inventory" means any area of operation that is inspected and permitted by the Carson City Health & Human Services based on the risk to public health.</u>
- 6. "Permit" means a written permit, stamp or seal of approval issued by the Carson Health & Human Services.
- 7. "Person" includes any natural individual, firm, trust, partnership, association, institution, corporation, or any other business entity and includes the plural as well as the singular, feminine as well as the masculine.
- 8 "Sanitary Code" means all of the rules and regulations pertaining to health, sanitation and environment which are adopted by the board of health of Carson City.

<u>Section III</u>: Title 7, Chapter 9.04.020 of the Carson City Municipal Code is hereby amended as follows:

9.04.020 - Permits required.

A health permit is required for the following establishments, businesses or activities:

- a. Food establishment inventories preparing, serving, selling or delivering food or drink for human consumption shall have a health permit as required by this title before beginning any operation, and shall be inspected accordingly, including, but not limited to, Convenience Stores, Retail Groceries, Ice Cream Shops, Retail Food Producers, Bakeries, Wholesale Distributing, Restaurants, Coffee Carts, Vending Machine Companies, Meat Departments, Bars and Lounges, Produce Departments, Seafood Departments, Mobile Ice Cream, Snow Cone Vehicles, Deli Departments, Child Care with Food Service, Mobile Food Vehicles, Caterers, Continental Breakfasts, Bed and Breakfasts, Take Outs, School Cafeterias and other fee exempt establishments, and Temporary Food Establishments.
- <u>b.</u> <u>Commercial and home</u> child care facility <u>inventories</u> <u>shall have a health permit</u> <u>as required by this title before beginning any operation, and shall be inspected annually in accordance with NAC 432A.260.</u>
- c. Public accommodation <u>inventories</u> <u>including</u> hotels <u>and</u> motels which provide accommodations to the transient public <u>shall have a health permit as required by this title before beginning any operation</u>, <u>and shall be inspected on an annual basis in accordance with NRS 447 and NAC 447.</u>
- d.] Mobile home park and recreational vehicle park inventories renting space for temporary or permanent parking of a mobile home, trailer or recreational vehicle shall have a health permit as required by this title before beginning any operation, and shall be inspected on an annual basis in accordance with NRS 461A and NAC 461A.
- e. Public bathing places inventories including swimming pools, hot springs, and spas shall have a health permit as required by this title before beginning any operation, and shall be inspected at least once a season in accordance with the Carson City Municipal Code and NRS 444.050-444.120 and NAC 444.010-444.546
- f. Invasive body decoration inventories including tattoo, body piercing and permanent cosmetic operations shall have a health permit as required by this title before beginning any operation, and shall be inspected on an annual basis in accordance with the Carson City Municipal Code.
- g. Public institution inventories including public and private elementary, middle, and high schools, shall have a health permit as required by this title before beginning any operation, and shall be inspected on a biannual basis in accordance with NRS 444.330-444.335 and NAC 444.568–444.56862.
- h. Bottled water plant inventories shall have a health permit as required by this title before beginning any operation, and shall be inspected on an annual basis in accordance with NAC 445A.544-445A.590.

i. Jail and detention center inventories shall have a health permit as required by this title before beginning any operation, and shall be inspected on an annual basis in accordance with NAC 211.

<u>Section IV</u>: Title 9, Chapter 9.04.030 of the Carson City Municipal Code is hereby amended as follows:

9.04.030 - Duties of the permit holder.

The owner, person in charge or control, or the lessee, of every <u>inventory</u>, establishment, premises, place, potable water supply, sewerage or drainage system has the duty to and shall keep, place and preserve the same in such condition, and to conduct and maintain the same in such manner, that it shall not be dangerous to the public health or in violation of the rules and regulations of the Sanitary Code.

<u>Section V</u>: Title 9, Chapter 9.04.040 of the Carson City Municipal Code is hereby amended as follows:

9.04.040 - Permits, approvals and other requirements.

- 1. No person shall engage in one (1) of the activities enumerated in Section 9.04.020 without first obtaining a permit from the <u>CCHHS unless permitted under another governmental public health agency</u>.
- 2. Permit applications shall be made on forms provided by the <u>CCHHS</u> or by submission of plot plans or construction drawings, and shall be completed in all pertinent details.
- 3. No application for permit shall receive approval until a complete health inspection has been made and all deficiencies corrected. The applicant shall demonstrate to the <u>CCHHS</u> compliance with all pertinent state and municipal health laws, regulations and ordinances before a permit will be issued.
- 4. In cases where the submission of plans and/or specifications is required, no construction, modification or adaptation shall commence, except that required to eliminate, remove or minimize imminent or immediate danger to the public health and well-being, unless the required plans have been approved. Construction shall be in conformance with the approved plans and specifications.
- 5. The approval of plans and specifications shall lapse and become invalid one (1) year from the date of approval if the majority (one-half (1/2) or more) portion of the work

described in the plans and specifications has not commenced by such anniversary date.

- 6. Permits are valid for one (1) year from the date of issuance thereof unless suspended or revoked by the <u>CCHHS</u> for violation of the <u>Sanitary Code</u>. <u>Each inventory is to be charged separately.</u> Fees collected for such permits are not refundable. No permit is transferable from person to person or place to place.
- 7. Every permit must at all times be kept on the premises or in the vehicle designated and displayed in a conspicuous manner therein. 8. No permit shall be issued and no permit is valid until the bona fide permit fee is received by the <u>CCHHS</u> or its designated representative:
 - a. By cash, check, money order, <u>credit_card</u> or cashier check to the CCHD <u>CCHHS</u> or its <u>designated representative</u> at the time of application.
 - b. Once an operator of a <u>properly</u> licensed business within Carson City has been issued health <u>permits</u>, billing for <u>fees</u> to cover a subsequent year will be mailed prior to the expiration date of <u>each</u> permit. Payment for the health <u>permits</u> must be made prior to issuance of any business license. Fees shall be paid according to the following schedule:

- 9. Replacement certificates/permits may be obtained from the <u>CCHHS</u> on payment of a fee of two dollars (\$2.00). Such documents shall be marked "Duplicate."
- 10. No person shall refuse to allow the <u>CCHHS</u> to inspect fully any and all premises of facilities at any reasonable time, and no person shall interfere with the <u>CCHHS</u> on the discharge of its duties whether in inspections for application approval or for the enforcement of the sanitary code. Refusal to allow inspection or interference with the <u>CCHHS</u> shall be grounds for refusal of a permit.
- 11. Anyone aggrieved by the refusal to grant a permit may within five (5) days of such refusal appeal in writing to the Carson City board of supervisors which shall conduct a hearing thereon.

<u>Section VI</u>: Title 9, Chapter 9.04.050 of the Carson City Municipal Code is hereby amended as follows:

9.04.050 - Revocation or suspension.

- 1. Permits issued under the provisions of this chapter may be suspended temporarily by the <u>CCHHS</u> for failure of the holder to comply with the requirements of this chapter. Whenever a permit holder is found to be in noncompliance with the provisions of this chapter, the permit holder shall be given a written notice thereof, such written notice to specify in detail the corrective measures necessary to bring the permit holder back into compliance, and a time period for implementation.
- 2. Any person whose permit has been suspended may, at any time, make application

for a reinspection for the purpose of reinstatement of the permit. Within ten (10) days following receipt of a written request, including a statement signed by the applicant that the conditions causing the suspension of the permit have been corrected, <u>CCHHS</u> shall make a reinspection. If the applicant is complying with the requirements of this chapter, the permit shall be reinstated.

- 3. For serious or repeated violations of any of the requirements of this chapter or for the interference with the <u>CCHHS</u> in the performance of its duties, the permit may be permanently revoked following an opportunity for a hearing before the board of supervisors. Any permit holder whose permit is being considered for revocation shall be notified by certified mail, return receipt requested. The permit shall be permanently revoked at the end of five (5) days following the date of service of such notice, unless a request for a hearing is filed with the <u>CCHHS</u> within such five (5) day period. A permit may be suspended for cause pending its revocation or a hearing relative thereto.
- 4. The hearings provided for in this section shall be conducted by the board of supervisors at a time and place designated by them. Based upon the record of such hearing, the board of supervisors shall make a finding and shall sustain, modify or rescind any official notice or order considered in the hearing. A written report of the hearing decision shall be furnished to the permit holder by the <u>CCHHS</u>.

<u>Section VII</u>: Title 9, Chapter 9.04.060 of the Carson City Municipal Code is hereby amended as follows:

9.04.060 - Penalties.

Any person who violates any of the provisions of this chapter is guilty of a misdemeanor.

In addition thereto, such persons may be enjoined from continuing such violations. Each day upon which such a violation occurs shall constitute a separate violation.

The Carson City Health & Human Services provides numerous programs and services to the public. The programs and services include, but are not limited to, well-baby examinations, vaccinations, disease investigation, family planning, physical examinations and the administration of medications. CCHHS has the authority to set reasonable fees to provide these services and programs to the public. Such fees for the programs and services must be set for the sole purpose of defraying the costs and expenses of the programs and services and not for the purposes of general revenue.

<u>Section VIII</u>: Title 9, Chapter 9.04.065 of the Carson City Municipal Code is hereby deleted but reserved for future use

<u>Section IX</u>: Title 9, Chapter 9.04.070 of the Carson City Municipal Code is hereby deleted but reserved for future use

Reserved.

<u>Section X:</u> If any clause, sentence, section, provision or part of this chapter shall be adjudged to be unconstitutional or invalid for any reason by any court of competent jurisdiction, such judgment shall not invalidate, impair or affect the remainder of this chapter.

<u>Section XI:</u> That no other provisions of the Carson City Municipal Code are affected by this ordinance.
