Subject Title: For Possible Action: Action to adopt, on second reading, Bill Number 112, an ordinance amending the Carson City Municipal Code Title 12 – Water, Sewerage and Drainage, Chapter 12.12 – Solid Waste Management, Section 12.12.047 – Landfill rates and fees, by: Modifying the solid waste categories to make MSW Compacted a single category; adjusting In-County Fees (1,000 lbs or greater) for the MSW Compacted category annually in May using the annual percentage change in the Consumer Price Index for all Urban Consumers (CPI-U) – US City Average, Garbage and Trash Collection, as published by the Bureau of Labor Statistics, Washington D.C., commencing with the index for the twelve month period ending December 31, 2012 and each percentage change annually thereafter. In no year shall the adjustment be less than zero or more than six percent (6%). The term shall coincide with the term of the Solid Waste and Recyclable Materials Franchise Agreement, Chapter 5.10 of the Carson City Municipal Code; and other matters properly related thereto. Staff Summary: The proposed ordinance amendment will help cover inflationary costs at the Carson City Landfill and will only impact the one categorical user, Capital Sanitation Company. Under the Solid Waste and Recyclable Material Franchise Agreement, Capital Sanitation Company already receives this index rate increase annually.

Explanation for Recommended Board Action: With the passing of this ordinance, the Carson City Solid Waste Franchisee disposal charges for compacted materials will be indexed to the annual CPI-U for Garbage and Trash Collection.

Fiscal Impact: After approval of second reading, the Carson City landfill will see an increase in revenues.

Explanation of Impact: The passage of this measure will increase compacted waste disposal fees directly to Carson City's' Solid Waste Franchisee since they are the only business customer in this landfill disposal class. The increase will not impact fees associated with other users of the landfill.

ORDINANCE WATER, AN AMENDING TITLE 12. SEWERAGE, AND DRAINAGE, CHAPTER 12.12, SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT, SECTION 12.12.047, LANDFILL RATES AND FEES, BY MODIFYING RATE CLASSES. ANNUALLY ADJUSTING IN-COUNTY FEES (1,000 LBS OR GREATER) **FOR** MSW COMPACTED CATEGORY. EFFECTIVE MAY 19, 2012 AND OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATED THERETO.

THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF CARSON CITY DO ORDAIN:

SECTION I: That Section 12.12.047 of is hereby amended as follows:

To receive Carson City residential rates, the landfill customer must show proof of residency.

To receive the Wood Waste, Green Yard Waste, or Class III (inert) rates the loads must be comprised strictly of that material only. If the loads do not conform to this and are mixed in nature, the loads will be charged at the rate for the most expensive

material. EXAMPLE: a load is predominately Class III but contains any amount of asbestos containing material, the complete load will be charged at the rate for asbestos.
