WHEREAS, the representative form of government is founded upon a belief that those entrusted with the offices of government have nothing to fear from full public disclosure of their business holdings as they pertain to the business before the Carson City board of supervisors; and

WHEREAS, the Carson City board of supervisors intends to sustain, to the extent necessary, public confidence in government at all levels by assuring the people of the impartiality and honesty of their officials in all governmental transactions and decisions; and

WHEREAS, Nevada Revised Statutes 281A.020 specifically enumerates specific legislative findings and declarations in regards to Ethics in Government; and

WHEREAS, it is the intent of Carson City to continue to comply with the State's ethics requirements;

NOW, THEREFORE, LET IT BE KNOWN AND RESOLVED that Carson City supports the express language and the spirit of the ethics provisions adopted by the Nevada State Legislature.
