**A RESOLUTION ADOPTING AND APPROVING COMPENSATION FOR
ELECTION BOARD WORKERS AND EARLY VOTING WORKERS**

WHEREAS, pursuant to Carson City Charter, the Board of Supervisors are invested with powers to regulate elections; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Article 5 of the Carson City Municipal Code and in order to carry out the election process, Carson City Board of Supervisors has adopted resolutions in the past establishing compensation for Election Board Workers and Early Voting Workers; and

WHEREAS, the Carson City Board of Supervisors finds that it is necessary and within the public interest to set the compensation which has been at the same rate as the Board established in 2008.

NOW, THEREFORE, this Board hereby resolves to set compensation for Election Board Workers and Early Voting Workers, as follows:

1. Team Leaders - \$200;
2. Information Clerks - \$125
3. Assistant Team Leaders - \$80;
4. Intake Clerks - \$60;
5. Card Collectors - \$50; and
4. Early Voting Workers - \$12.30 per hour.
