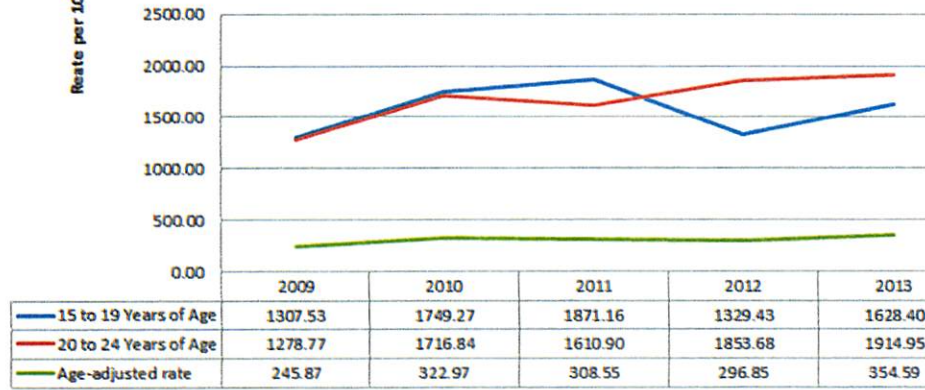

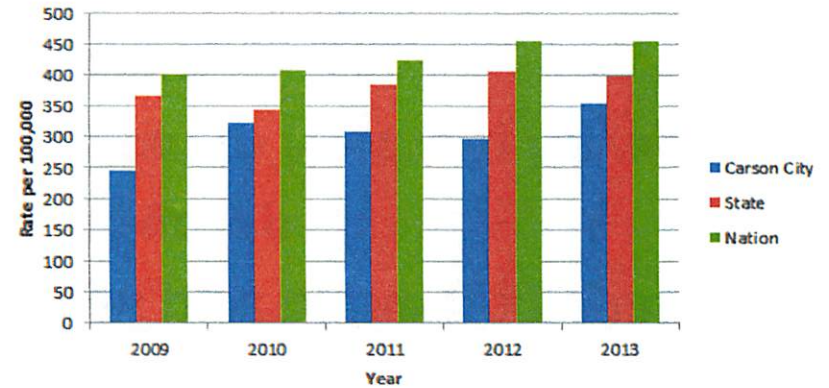


Epidemiology Program

 - Douglas County - **115** in 7 elementary schools

- * Looked up all 6th grade students in WebIZ prior to vaccination
 - Carson - **534**
 - Douglas - **502**

- * Assisted Pioneer High School with catch-up vaccinations
 - Looked up 200 students in WebIZ and sent 58 letters
 - Vaccinated 14 students with Hep A and Varicella

- * Fall flu clinics scheduled in September and October - Carson City and Douglas County schools
