Subject Title: For Possible Action: To approve a proposed amendment to Carson City's Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) 2014-2015 Annual Action Plan to reallocate the funds dedicated for the FISH Jeanell Drive Building Renovation project to be used for improvements at the FISH facility at 138 E. Long Street. (Lee Plemel)

Summary: FISH was awarded \$20,743 in CDBG funds in FY2014 for the Jeanell Drive Building Renovation project. Since the 2014 Annual Action Plan was approved on May 1, 2014, FISH has determined that the property on Jeanell Drive has the potential for a large supportive housing project funded by tax credits and HOME funds and that the CDBG funding would be better used at their facility located at 138 E. Long Street. Federal regulation 24 CFR 91.505 and Carson City's Citizen Participation Plan require a substantial amendment to the Annual Action Plan if there is a change in the use of CDBG funds from one eligible activity to another.

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Introduction

Carson City receives federal funds from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development through the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) entitlement program. The CDBG program is designed to assist in the development of viable communities by supporting projects that provide decent housing, suitable living environments, and expanded economic opportunities primarily for low- and moderate-income persons. In order to receive these funds, Carson City must submit a 5-year Consolidated Plan. For each year of the 5-year plan, Carson City is required under Title 24 Section 91.220 of the Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) to adopt an Annual Action Plan for the use of these funds, which serves as the means to meet the application and submission requirements for the CDBG program.

Carson City's first year 2014-2015 Annual Action Plan was approved the Board of Supervisors on May 1, 2014 and submitted to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development on July 14, 2014. The plan allocated the City's CDBG funds in a manner consistent with CDBG regulations and Carson City's Consolidated Plan.

Friends in Service Helping (FISH) was granted \$20,743 for the Jeanell Drive Building Renovation project. Since the 2014 Annual Action Plan was approved, FISH has determined that the property on Jeanell Drive has the potential for a large supportive housing project funded by tax credits and HOME funds and that the CDBG funding would be better used at their facility located at 138 E. Long Street.

Federal regulation 24 CFR 91.505 and Carson City's Citizen Participation Plan require a substantial amendment to the Annual Action Plan if there is a change in funding allocation priorities described in the consolidated plan, a new activity not previously described in an annual action plan, a change in the use of CDBG funds from one eligible activity to another, or a budget amendment of more than \$50,000.

Carson City must complete a substantial amendment to the 2014-2015 Annual Action Plan since there will be a change in the use of CDBG funds from one eligible activity to another.

Proposed Action Plan Amendment

Carson City is proposing a substantial amendment that will eliminate the originally approved Jeanell Drive Building Renovation project and replace it with the 2014 FISH Facility Improvement Project. The new project would take place at the FISH facility at 138 E. Long Street and would include the following activities:

- Replacement of outdated HVAC equipment
- Mechanical, electrical, and plumbing renovations
- Restroom and thrift store renovations

Project Description and Objectives

The FISH Facility Improvement project will replace the outdated HVAC equipment and improve the facility to include mechanical, electrical, plumbing, restroom, and thrift store renovations. FISH has received CDBG funding for the past 4 years and has significantly improved their facilities. These additional renovations would further improve the safety, efficiency, and appearance of the facility that serves the low-income and homeless population of Carson City.

Citizen Participation

In accordance with 24 CFR 91.105(c)(3) for local governments, Carson City will provide citizen's the opportunity to review and comment on the substantial amendment by following the procedures outlined in the Citizen Participation Plan. To encourage citizen participation in the review and approval of the substantial amendment, Carson City will:

- Publish a notice of availability of the draft amendment in the Nevada Appeal a minimum
 of 14 days before the public hearing and public comment period. The notice will include
 a summary of the amendment and a list of the locations where copies of the amendment
 may be examined. The City will also maintain a mailing list of all interested parties and
 send information regarding the amendment to all members of the mailing list.
- Hold a public hearing on the proposed substantial amendment. Notice of the public hearing will be released to area media and published in the local newspaper at least 14 days in advance of the hearing.
- Provide a period of at least 30 days to receive comments on the substantial amendment before the amendment is implemented. The City will consider any comments or views of citizens received in writing, or orally at public hearings, if any, when adopting the amendment. The City will attach a summary of these comments and the City's response to the final adopted amendment.

Public Hearing and Comment Period

The notice of public hearing and notice of comment period for the substantial amendment will appear in the Nevada Appeal on October 19, 2014. The 30 day comment period will begin on November 6, 2014 and end on December 5, 2014. Carson City will consider any comments received before approval of the proposed substantial amendment. A summary of the comments will be included in the substantial amendment submitted to HUD for approval.

Approval of the final Annual Action Plan amendment will take place during the Board of Supervisors meeting to be held on December 18, 2014 at 8:30 a.m. in the Sierra Room, 851 E. William Street, Carson City, NV 89701.
