

# PROCLAMATION

## In Appreciation of Alvin P. Kramer

**WHEREAS**, Al Kramer began his career with the Carson City Treasurer's Office in 1995 as the elected Treasurer; and

**WHEREAS**, Al served five terms as the elected Treasurer for Carson City, Nevada, during which time modern cash management tools were implemented. During his tenure, through automation, staff was reduced by fifty percent while absorbing new duties; and

**WHEREAS**, Al implemented a FICA alternative plan for Carson City that has saved the City over \$80,000 each year for the past 15 years. Carson City was the first entity in the State to start such a plan; and

**WHEREAS**, Al successfully submitted a bill to the Nevada Legislature which changed Nevada Law to allow delinquent water/sewer/storm drain utility bills to be moved to the tax roll. This allowed Carson City to become the first "No Turn Off" utility in the State. Under Al's administration of 20 years, only three parcels were sold for non - payment of taxes; and

**WHEREAS**, Al's 20 years of hard work and dedication have been outstanding. He has worked tirelessly on various committees and testified at numerous legislative sessions. Al has been an advocate for Carson City and has an enduring commitment to improving and enhancing Carson City; and

**WHEREAS**, Al will be missed by all those who have had the pleasure of working with him - both City staff and the public.

**NOW THEREFORE**, I, Robert L. Crowell, Mayor of Carson City, Nevada on behalf of the Board of Supervisors, do hereby extend this proclamation and our sincerest appreciation to Al Kramer for his incredible service to Carson City and wish him well in his retirement.
