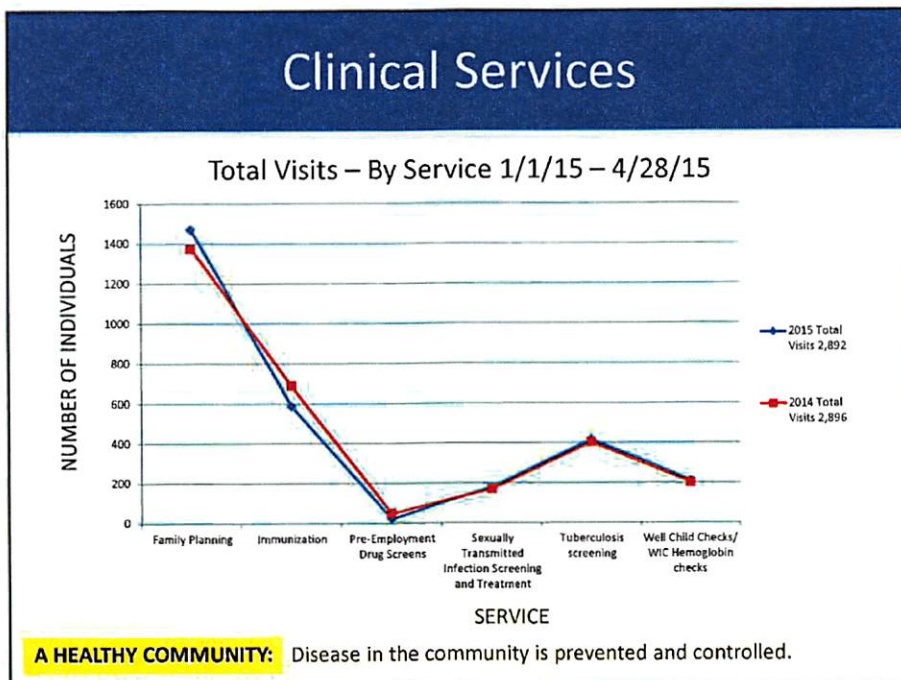
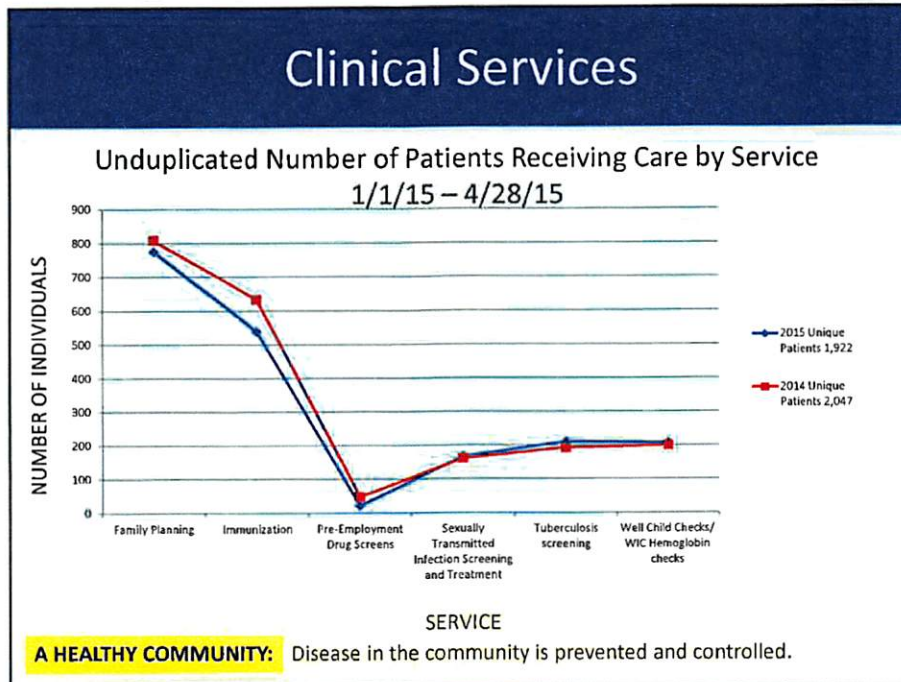


Human Services

Medicaid Enrollment

- Clinical Services in collaboration with the State of Nevada Department of Public and Behavioral Health offers Medicaid enrollment Services one day a week (Mondays) at CCHHS. From Nov 2014 – March 31:
 - Number of individuals assisted - 109;
 - Number of individuals receiving eligibility determination - 109;
 - Number of individuals enrolled in Medicaid - 98
 - Number of individual provided insurance information and referred to the Health Insurance Exchange - 11

2014 Complaints

- 31 complaints against food establishments
 - 6 (19%) were confirmed
 - 25 (80%) were unconfirmed
 - (1) an official notice was issued

Epidemiology Program

From January to April, we conducted 10 investigations related to possible Measles. All Nevada cases were in Clark County.

5 Outbreaks representing 93% of reported cases this year
