## 5. Discussion and Year-End Summary of activities at the Carson City Digitorium; to include use in the Future

The On Line and On Time grant is coming to the end of its grant cycle. With the support of Carson City and the Carson City School District the impact the project has on community students will not go unfunded moving into FY16.

In the past year, students created public service announcements on a range of topics that include persuasive messages about things like healthy eating, how to get good grades, and why it makes a difference to join a school club or team. Through the Library Services Technology Act On Line On Time program, 21<sup>st</sup> century learning is taking place beyond the classroom. The Digitorium space proved to be a success! All freshmen have uploaded PSA's to their digital portfolio in the first half of 2016. In 2016-17 the Library looks to grow the partnership beyond CCSD freshman, to all levels and expand digital literacy skills taught and practiced in the space.

Informational Update on the Manufacturing Technician 1 (MT1) Program at the Carson City Library and Western Nevada College and its Integration in the Jump Start Program The Carson City Library is in full partnership with Western Nevada College (WNC), collaborating with the Manufacturing Skills Institute (MSI), the 501(c) 3 affiliate of the National Association of Manufacturers (NAM) and the Virginia Manufacturers Association (VMA) to produce, "Nevada's Working Capital", an Library Services Technology Act grant awarded by the Nevada State Library and Archives.

One aspect of "Nevada's Working Capital" is formal (at WNC through Automated & Industrial Systems classes, and JumpStart for Carson City School District) and informal (at the Carson City Library) learning opportunities that directly lead to a Manufacturing Technician 1 (MT1) certificate. The MT1 is a nationally portable and NAM endorsed credential demonstrating understanding of essential industry-wide technical skills for existing and emerging employers in advanced manufacturing.
