A RESOLUTION OF THE CARSON CITY FIRE DEPARTMENT IDENTIFYING THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR FIRE DEPARTMENT RESPONSE AWAY FROM THEIR OFFICIAL DUTY STATION AND ASSIGNED TO AN EMERGENCY INCIDENT IN CALIFORNIA.

WHEREAS, the Carson City Fire Department is a public agency located in Carson City, State of Nevada; and

WHEREAS, it is the Carson City Fire Department's desire to provide fair and legal payment to all its employees for time worked; and

WHEREAS, the Carson City Fire Department has in its employ, Fire Department response personnel including: Fire Chief, Deputy Chief, Battalion Chief, Fire Captain, Firefighter/Paramedic, Firefighter/EMT, Driver Operator; and

WHEREAS, the Carson City Fire Department will compensate its employees portal to portal while in the course of their employment and away from their official duty station and assigned to an emergency incident, in support of an emergency incident, or pre-positioned for emergency response; and

WHEREAS, the Carson City Fire Department will compensate its employees overtime in accordance with their current Association Contract's while in the course of their employment and away from their official duty station and assigned to an emergency incident, in support of an emergency incident, or pre-positioned for emergency response.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it hereby resolved by the City of Carson City that:

- Personnel shall be compensated according to the current Association Contract's, Personnel Rules and Regulations, and/or other directive that identifies personnel compensation in the workplace.
- 2. In the event a personnel classification does not have an assigned compensation rate, a "Base Rate" as set forth in an organizational policy, administrative directive or similar document will to compensate such personnel.
- 3. The Carson City Fire Department will maintain a <u>current</u> salary survey or acknowledgement of acceptance of the "base rate" on file with the California Governor's Office of Emergency Services, Fire Rescue Division.
- 4. Personnel will be compensated (portal to portal) beginning at the time of dispatch to the return to jurisdiction when equipment and personnel are in service and available for agency response.
