**REQUEST:** 

<u>For possible action:</u> To approve staff's recommendation for the allocation of Residential Construction Tax funds for FY 2015/2016 to

improvement projects to Ross Gold Park.

GENERAL DISCUSSION: Attached as Exhibit A is a budget project list of Residential Construction Tax (RCT) committed projects. The budget shows a \$135,290.23 cash balance. Since the last printout, we have reimbursed \$77,896.21 in liability to Silver Oak Development for reimbursement for the construction of John Mankins Park. In addition, the \$10,235.85 left in the Centennial Park ADA improvement project is encumbered to cover ordered accessible picnic tables and benches. The estimated total cost for the tables and benches is \$10,225.30. The project list also includes \$83,656 budgeted for Theater improvements. Based on the newest Residential Construction Tax NRS, staff does not believe that this is an appropriate RCT expenditure. Therefore, staff is recommending that these funds be reallocated to a neighborhood park project. Therefore the cash balance minus the encumbered Centennial Park funds amounts to \$135,290.23.

Staff provided an update on the RCT budget during the September 1, 2015 Parks & Recreation Commission meeting, and committed to bringing a recommended revised allocation plan for approval to the Commission in the October meeting. The commission asked whether staff would consider opening up this process for public input. After much consideration, staff has decided to not open the process up as the funding level is still relatively low and because we have so many unfunded capital improvement needs. Attached as Exhibit B, is our FY15/16 Minor and Major Capital Budget Requests.

Staff is recommending that we use the entire amount of the available RCT funds for improvements to Ross Gold Park. Ross Gold Park is located in south Carson City at Appion Way and California Street, and has serious needs. These improvements include the replacement of its aged playground equipment, picnic shelter and its asphalt pathways who's condition that has degenerated beyond maintenance solutions

**RECOMMENDED ACTION:** I move to approve staff's recommendation for the allocation of Residential Construction Tax funds for FY 2015/16 to improvement projects to Ross Gold Park.
