Nevada Day *“Nevada, One State Many Cultures”*

WHEREAS, Nevada was admitted as the “36th” state in the sisterhood of the states on October 31, 1864, by signature of the President of the United States of America, Abraham Lincoln, and

WHEREAS, “Admissions Day” became a legal holiday in Nevada by legislative action in 1891 some 27 years after formal admission and when a handful of history-minded Nevadans began the tradition of celebrating “Nevada’s admissions, said celebrations occurring in the city of Reno from m1891 through 1937; and

WHEREAS, Judge Clark J. Guild spearheaded the relocation of the “Grand Birthday Party” to Carson City in 1938, which was the 74th anniversary of the “Battle Born State” and this year, 2015, marks Carson’s City’s 77th anniversary of the “Nevada Day” Celebrations; and

WHEREAS, this is the culminating year of the 151st anniversary of the State of Nevada, recognized as the official holiday on October 31, 2015, and celebrated on October 31 2015.

NOW, THEREFORE, I Robert L. Crowell, Mayor of Carson City, Nevada on this 151st anniversary of the great State of Nevada encourage all residents, friends, visitors and spectators alike to pause in honor of this momentous event and to join in the spirit of this year’s theme *“Nevada, One State Many Cultures.”*
