**Staff Summary:** Each year we bring the vendors that we do a majority of the IT purchases with to the Board of Supervisors for approval. While many of the individual purchases and projects are not significant themselves, when combined together throughout the year they have a significant total cost to the city. This year is no exception and we are requesting you approve these major vendors for IT Hardware, Software and Services not to exceed \$500,000 in total. This amount was derived from looking at our historical yearly purchases.

- 4. Any discounts are minimum discounts and any rates are not-to-exceed rates.
- Contractor will offer Public Agencies the lowest possible price for which they are eligible 5. under any contract available to the customer through this contract award. Insight will check for lowest possible price when an order is placed.
- Any End User License Agreements (EULA's) referenced in Contractor's proposal is not incorporated as a part of the contract.
- 7. The Lead Public Agency acknowledges for itself and on behalf of each Participating Public Agency electing to procure under the Master Agreement that it may be required to execute one or more applicable Contractor standard contract documents if and when it orders one or more technology product, service/solution. At the time that an order for a technology product, service/solution is placed by a Public Agency, the Public Agency will review the applicable standard contract document(s) and, if acceptable to each particular Public Agency, complete and sign such document(s). Contractor agrees and acknowledges that if and when an order for one or more technology product, service/solution is placed by Lead Public Agency, Contractor may be required to execute a Contract Addendum substantially in the form attached hereto as License Agreement Addendum.
- 8. In the event that additional third-party products are procured under the Contract, the Contractor agrees to provide a copy of any and all applicable third-party agreements for review by the County. The County reserves the right to negotiate the terms and conditions of the third-party agreements associated with the use of the third-party products prior to issuing the purchase order for additional products.
- The parties agree that any Statement/Scope of Work (SOW) and/or Service Level Agreement will be subject to negotiations and will be binding upon the parties and set forth in a written amendment to the Contract signed by the County Purchasing Agent and the Contractor.

- 1. Scope: Contractor and the Division of Purchasing and General Services, an agency of the Lead State have executed State Cooperative Contract, Contract Number AR602 for Data Communications Products and Services 2014-2019 ("WSCA-NASPO Master Price Agreement" or "Master Agreement"). The Master Agreement, as now or hereafter amended, is incorporated into this addendum ("Participating Addendum") as if set forth at length. This Participating Addendum covers the Data Communications Products and Services contracts led by the State of Utah for use by all governmental entities within the State of Nevada including all State Agencies, the University and Community College System, the Court System, Legislative Counsel Bureau, Cities, Counties, Institutions of higher education, political subdivisions and other entities located in the Participating State/Entity authorized by that state's statutes to utilize state/entity contracts with the prior approval of the state's chief procurement official.
- 2. <u>Participation:</u> Use of specific WSCA-NASPO cooperative contracts by agencies, political subdivisions and other entities (including cooperatives) authorized by an individual state's statutes to use state/entity contracts are subject to the prior approval of the respective State Chief Procurement Official. Issues of interpretation and eligibility for participation are solely within the authority of the State Chief Procurement Official.
  - a. Political Subdivision Participation: Participation under this contract by political subdivisions (i.e. colleges, school districts, counties, cities, etc.) will be voluntarily determined by the political subdivision. The contractor agrees to supply the political subdivisions based upon the same terms, conditions and prices.
- 3. Participating State Modifications or Additions to Master Agreement:
  - a. Purchase Orders: Orders over \$5,000.00 for Nevada State Agencies will be placed by formal purchase order issued by the Nevada State Purchasing Division. All orders will be shipped promptly in accordance with delivery guarantee and invoices shall be submitted to Nevada State Purchasing for payment. Invoices and all correspondence related to an individual order will reflect the purchase order number issued by the Nevada State Purchasing Division. Orders under \$5,000.00 may be purchased direct by the using agency.

- b. <u>Jurisdiction and Venues</u> This Contract, its amendments and supplements thereto, shall be governed by the laws of the State of Nevada. Venue for all legal proceedings arising out of the Contract, or breach thereof, shall be in the State or Federal Court with competent jurisdiction in Carson City, Nevada.
- c. Termination of the Participating Addendum: This Participating Addendum may be canceled by the State of Nevada, Purchasing Division at any time, with or without cause, upon 30 days written notice to the contract vendor. In the event the contract vendor is in default, the contract is subject to immediate cancellation to the extent allowable by applicable law. In the event of such a cancellation, the contract vendor shall be entitled to payment, determined on a pro rata basis, for work or services satisfactorily performed and accepted. This Participating Addendum may be canceled by the contract vendor upon 60 days written notice to the State of Nevada, Purchasing Division.
- d. Services: All onsite services such as installation, de-installation, training or ongoing maintenance, excluding warranty and break/fix support, requested by State agencies will require the implementation of an Independent Contract for Services per NRS 333, NAC 333 and SAM 0300.
- e. <u>Delivery:</u> Contractor will use commercially reasonable efforts to ship all orders designated for shipment within 30 days for all products. Shipping terms are FOB destination, shipping and handling prepaid by the Contractor. All sales are final except as provided in Contractor's Limited Warranty.
- f. <u>Payment:</u> Payment for completion of a contract order is normally made within 30 days following the date the entire order is delivered or the date a correct invoice is received, whichever is later. After 45 days the Contractor may assess overdue account charges up to a maximum rate of one percent per month on the outstanding balance. Payments will be remitted by mail, EFT or via a State or political subdivision "Purchasing Card" with no additional charge.
- g. <u>Evaluation Equipment:</u> If the contractor, by mutual agreement with the Participating Entity, wishes to allow the use of equipment for the purposes of evaluation prior to purchase, these "try and buy" acquisitions must be approved in writing by the Purchasing
