

What is Mental Health?

Mental health is a state of well-being in which every individual realizes his or her own potential, can cope with the normal stresses of life, can work productively and is able to make a contribution to his or her community.

-World Health Organization

A mental illness is a condition that affects a person's thinking, feeling or mood. Such conditions may affect someone's ability to relate to others and function each day. Each person will have different experiences, even people with the same diagnosis.

- National Alliance on Mental Health (NAMI)

A *mental illness* is a health condition characterized by alterations in thinking, mood or behavior associated with distress and impaired functioning.

Quick Statistics

1 of 5 adults experience a mental health condition every year. The most common conditions are depression and anxiety disorders.

6 of 100 adults lives with a serious mental illness such as bipolar disorder or schizophrenia.

7 of 10 children (ages 8-15) had a diagnosable mental disorder within the last year (ADHD, mood disorders, and depressive disorders).

Half of mental health conditions begin by midadolescence, three-quarters by age 24.

More than two-thirds of Americans who have a mental illness live in the community and lead productive lives.


Carson City Statistics

Population - About 55,000 (2% of Nevada's residents)

7,700 citizens with a mental health condition at any point in time (20% of adults)

2,000 with a serious mental health condition like bipolar disorder, schizophrenia or major depression (6% of adults)
